Iowa Football — Offense Trends + Notes — 2021-2023 01/02/24

Trends:

The Hawkeyes are now 70-9 when rushing for 100 yards or more in a game over the past 8 seasons - and 11-25 when failing to do that (113 net rush yards vs. Tennessee). The Hawkeyes are also 50-5 when scoring 20 or more points in a game since the start of the 2017 Season - and just 10-23 when scoring less than 20 points (0 points vs. Tennessee).

Points:

The season total remains at 201 points and the average decreased to 14.36 points per game — the team failed to reach or surpass the 25 point mark 12 times in its 14 games (Tennessee 35 - Iowa 0). The 2023 "Drive to 25" (doesn't matter anymore with the firing of Brian Ferentz) came up short again in Game 14 by 25 points (0).

The Hawkeyes Points Differential decreased by 35 to +256 over the last 47 games.

Notes:

In the 14th game of the 2023-24 Season, Iowa's Offense scored no touchdowns (0 pass + 0 rush) — season total remains 20 Offensive Touchdowns and the average has decreased to 1.43 Offensive Touchdowns per game.

In the 13 games of the 2022-23 Season, Iowa's Offense scored 19 touchdowns, averaging 1.46 Offensive Touchdowns per game. In the last 8 games of the 2021-22 Season, Iowa's Offense scored 11 touchdowns, averaging 1.38 Offensive Touchdowns per game. That is an average of 1.43 Offensive touchdowns per game over those 21 games. Including the 14 games in the 2023-24 Season, Iowa's Offense has scored a total of 50 touchdowns, and the average over those 35 games is only 1.43 touchdowns per game.
