

Iowa Football – Offense Trends + Notes

Trends:

The Hawkeyes are now 62-8 when rushing for 100 yards or more in a game over the past 8 seasons - and 10-22 when failing to do that (88 net rush yards vs. Utah State). The Hawkeyes are also 45-5 when scoring 20 or more points in a game since the start of the 2017 Season - and just 7-18 when scoring less than 20 points (24 points vs. Utah State).

Points:

The 2023 “Drive to 25” came up 1 point short in Game 1 – Season average is 24 points per game (Iowa 24 - Utah State 14).

The Hawkeyes Points Differential increased by 10 to +257 over the last 34 games (Final: Iowa 24 - Utah State 14).

Notes:

In the first game of the 2023 Season, Iowa’s Offense scored 3 TDs (2 pass, 1 rush) – averaging 3.0 Offensive TDs per game.

In the 13 games of the 2022-23 Season, Iowa’s Offense scored 19 TDs, averaging 1.46 Offensive Touchdowns per game (1 Offensive TD vs. Kentucky). In the last 8 games of the 2021-22 Season Iowa’s Offense scored 11 TDs, averaging 1.38 Offensive TDs per game. That is an average of 1.43 Offensive TDs per game over the last 21 games.
