Offensive In-Game Trends + Points Differential

Trends:

The Hawkeyes are now up to 58-7 when rushing for 100 yards or more in a game over the past 7 seasons - and 6-18 when failing to do that. (57 rush yards vs. South Dakota State).

The Hawkeyes are also now 38-5 when scoring 20 or more points in a game since the start of the 2017 Season - and just 6-13 when scoring less than 20 points. (7 points vs. South Dakota State).

Points:

The Hawkeyes Points Differential increased by 4 to +194 over the last 21 games. (Final: Iowa 7 - SDSU 3)

Additional Note:

Through the last 8 games of the 2021-22 Season (1.38 Offensive TDs per game) plus the first game of the 2022-23 Season, Iowa's Offense has averaged just 1.22 Offensive Touchdowns per game. (11 Offensive TDs ÷ 9 games = 1.22)
