

# Iowa Football – Offense Trends + Notes

## Trends:

The Hawkeyes are now 63-8 when rushing for 100 yards or more in a game over the past 8 seasons - and 10-22 when failing to do that (112 net rush yards vs. Iowa State). The Hawkeyes are also 46-5 when scoring 20 or more points in a game since the start of the 2017 Season - and just 7-18 when scoring less than 20 points (20 points vs. Iowa State).

## Points:

The 2023 “Drive to 25” came up 5 points short in Game 2 — season total is 44 points and average is 22.0 points per game (Iowa 20 - Iowa State 13).

The Hawkeyes Points Differential increased by 7 to +264 over the last 35 games (Final: Iowa 20 - Iowa State 13).

## Notes:

In the 2nd game of the 2023 Season, Iowa’s Offense scored 1 TD (1 rush) — season total is 4 Offensive TDs and the average is 2.0 Offensive TDs per game.

In the 13 games of the 2022-23 Season, Iowa’s Offense scored 19 TDs, averaging 1.46 Offensive Touchdowns per game (1 Offensive TD vs. Kentucky). In the last 8 games of the 2021-22 Season Iowa’s Offense scored 11 TDs, averaging 1.38 Offensive TDs per game. That is an average of 1.43 Offensive TDs per game over the last 21 games.
