

Iowa Football – Offense Trends + Notes

Trends:

The Hawkeyes are now 64-8 when rushing for 100 yards or more in a game over the past 8 seasons - and 10-23 when failing to do that (20 net rush yards vs. Penn State). The Hawkeyes are also 47-5 when scoring 20 or more points in a game since the start of the 2017 Season - and just 7-19 when scoring less than 20 points (0 points vs. Penn State).

Points:

The 2023 “Drive to 25” came up short for the 3rd time this season in Game 4 – season total remains 85 points and average dropped to 21.25 points per game (Iowa 0 - Penn State 31).

The Hawkeyes Points Differential decreased by 31 to +264 over the last 37 games.

Notes:

In the 4th game of the 2023 Season, Iowa's Offense scored 0 TDs (0 pass + 0 rush) – season total remains 9 Offensive TDs and the average has dropped to 2.25 Offensive TDs per game.

In the 13 games of the 2022-23 Season, Iowa's Offense scored 19 TDs, averaging 1.46 Offensive Touchdowns per game (1 Offensive TD vs. Kentucky). In the last 8 games of the 2021-22 Season Iowa's Offense scored 11 TDs, averaging 1.38 Offensive TDs per game. That is an average of 1.43 Offensive TDs per game over the last 21 games.
