Offensive In-Game Trends + Notes

Trends:

The Hawkeyes are now up to 60-7 when rushing for 100 yards or more in a game over the past 7 seasons - and 6-19 when failing to do that. (129 rush yards vs. Rutgers). The Hawkeyes are also now 40-5 when scoring 20 or more points in a game since the start of the 2017 Season - and just 6-14 when scoring less than 20 points. (27 points vs. Rutgers).

Points:

The Hawkeyes Points Differential increased by 17 to +235 over the last 24 games. (Final: Iowa 27 - Rutgers 10)

Notes:

Through the last 8 games of the 2021-22 Season Iowa's Offense averaged just 1.38 Offensive TDs per game. Through the first 4 games of the 2022-23 Season, Iowa's Offense has scored 5 TDs, averaging just 1.25 Offensive Touchdowns per game (1 Offensive TD vs. Rutgers).
