

# Iowa Football – Offense Trends + Notes

## Trends:

The Hawkeyes are now 64-8 when rushing for 100 yards or more in a game over the past 8 seasons - and 11-23 when failing to do that (61 net rush yards vs. Michigan State). The Hawkeyes are also 48-5 when scoring 20 or more points in a game since the start of the 2017 Season - and just 7-19 when scoring less than 20 points (26 points vs. Michigan State).

## Points:

The 2023 “Drive to 25” was surpassed tonight in Game 5 by 1 point (26) – season total increases to 111 points and average dropped to 22.2 points per game – the team has failed to reach or surpass the 25 point mark 3 times in its 5 games (Iowa 26 - Michigan State 16).

The Hawkeyes Points Differential increased by 10 to +274 over the last 38 games.

## Notes:

In the 5th game of the 2023 Season, Iowa’s Offense scored 1 TD (1 pass + 0 rush) – season total is now 10 Offensive TDs and the average has dropped to 2.00 Offensive TDs per game.

In the 13 games of the 2022-23 Season, Iowa’s Offense scored 19 TDs, averaging 1.46 Offensive Touchdowns per game (1 Offensive TD vs. Kentucky). In the last 8 games of the 2021-22 Season Iowa’s Offense scored 11 TDs, averaging 1.38 Offensive TDs per game. That is an average of 1.43 Offensive TDs per game over the last 21 games.
