Iowa Football — Offense Trends + Notes

Trends:

The Hawkeyes are now 65-8 when rushing for 100 yards or more in a game over the past 8 seasons - and 11-23 when failing to do that (181 net rush yards vs. Purdue). The Hawkeyes are also 49-5 when scoring 20 or more points in a game since the start of the 2017 Season - and just 7-19 when scoring less than 20 points (20 points vs. Purdue).

Points:

The 2023 "Drive to 25" came up short again today in Game 6 by 5 points (20) — season total increases to 131 points and average dropped to 21.8 points per game — the team has failed to reach or surpass the 25 point mark 4 times in its 6 games (Iowa 20 - Purdue 14).

The Hawkeyes Points Differential increased by 6 to +280 over the last 39 games.

Notes:

In the 6th game of the 2023 Season, Iowa's Offense scored 2 TDs (1 pass + 1 rush) — season total is now 12 Offensive TDs and the average is 2.00 Offensive TDs per game.

In the 13 games of the 2022-23 Season, Iowa's Offense scored 19 TDs, averaging 1.46 Offensive Touchdowns per game (1 Offensive TD vs. Kentucky). In the last 8 games of the 2021-22 Season Iowa's Offense scored 11 TDs, averaging 1.38 Offensive TDs per game. That is an average of 1.43 Offensive TDs per game over the last 21 games.
