

Iowa Football – Offense Trends + Notes

Trends:

The Hawkeyes are now 66-8 when rushing for 100 yards or more in a game over the past 8 seasons - and 11-23 when failing to do that (200 net rush yards vs. Wisconsin). The Hawkeyes are also 49-5 when scoring 20 or more points in a game since the start of the 2017 Season - and just 8-19 when scoring less than 20 points (15 points vs. Wisconsin).

Points:

The 2023 “Drive to 25” came up short again today in Game 7 by 10 points (15) – season total increases to 131 points and average dropped to 18.7 points per game – the team has failed to reach or surpass the 25 point mark 5 times in its 7 games (Iowa 15 - Wisconsin 6).

The Hawkeyes Points Differential increased by 9 to +289 over the last 40 games.

Notes:

In the 7th game of the 2023 Season, Iowa’s Offense scored 1 TD (0 pass + 1 rush) – season total is now 13 Offensive TDs and the average is 1.86 Offensive TDs per game.

In the 13 games of the 2022-23 Season, Iowa’s Offense scored 19 TDs, averaging 1.46 Offensive Touchdowns per game (1 Offensive TD vs. Kentucky). In the last 8 games of the 2021-22 Season Iowa’s Offense scored 11 TDs, averaging 1.38 Offensive TDs per game. That is an average of 1.43 Offensive TDs per game over the last 21 games.
