

Iowa Football – Offense Trends + Notes

Trends:

The Hawkeyes are now 66-8 when rushing for 100 yards or more in a game over the past 8 seasons - and 11-24 when failing to do that (11 net rush yards vs. Minnesota). The Hawkeyes are also 49-5 when scoring 20 or more points in a game since the start of the 2017 Season - and just 8-20 when scoring less than 20 points (10 points vs. Minnesota).

Points:

The 2023 “Drive to 25” came up short again today in Game 8 by 15 points (10) – season total increases to 141 points and average dropped to 17.6 points per game – the team has failed to reach or surpass the 25 point mark 6 times in its 8 games (Minnesota 12 - Iowa 10).

The Hawkeyes Points Differential decreased by 2 to +287 over the last 41 games.

Notes:

In the 8th game of the 2023 Season, Iowa’s Offense scored 1 TD (0 pass + 1 rush) – season total is now 14 Offensive TDs and the average has dropped to 1.75 Offensive TDs per game.

In the 13 games of the 2022-23 Season, Iowa’s Offense scored 19 TDs, averaging 1.46 Offensive Touchdowns per game (1 Offensive TD vs. Kentucky). In the last 8 games of the 2021-22 Season Iowa’s Offense scored 11 TDs, averaging 1.38 Offensive TDs per game. That is an average of 1.43 Offensive TDs per game over the last 21 games.
