

Iowa Football — Offense Trends + Notes

Trends:

The Hawkeyes are now 67-8 when rushing for 100 yards or more in a game over the past 8 seasons - and 11-24 when failing to do that (104 net rush yards vs. Northwestern). The Hawkeyes are also 49-5 when scoring 20 or more points in a game since the start of the 2017 Season - and just 9-20 when scoring less than 20 points (10 points vs. Northwestern).

Points:

The 2023 “Drive to 25” (not that it really matters anymore) came up short again today in Game 9 by 15 points (10) — season total increases to 151 points and average dropped to 16.8 points per game — the team has failed to reach or surpass the 25 point mark 7 times in its 9 games (Iowa 10 - Northwestern 7).

The Hawkeyes Points Differential increased by 3 to +290 over the last 42 games.

Notes:

In the 9th game of the 2023 Season, Iowa’s Offense scored 1 TD (1 pass + 0 rush) — season total is now 15 Offensive TDs and the average has dropped to 1.67 Offensive TDs per game.

In the 13 games of the 2022-23 Season, Iowa’s Offense scored 19 TDs, averaging 1.46 Offensive Touchdowns per game (1 Offensive TD vs. Kentucky). In the last 8 games of the 2021-22 Season Iowa’s Offense scored 11 TDs, averaging 1.38 Offensive TDs per game. That is an average of 1.43 Offensive TDs per game over the last 21 games.
