

Iowa Football — Offense Trends + Notes — 2021-2023

Trends:

The Hawkeyes are now 69-8 when rushing for 100 yards or more in a game over the past 8 seasons - and 11-24 when failing to do that (114 net rush yards vs. Illinois). The Hawkeyes are also 50-5 when scoring 20 or more points in a game since the start of the 2017 Season - and just 10-20 when scoring less than 20 points (15 points vs. Illinois).

Points:

The season total increases to 188 points and the average decreased to 17.1 points per game — the team has failed to reach or surpass the 25 point mark 9 times in its 11 games (Iowa 15 - Illinois 13). The 2023 “Drive to 25” (not that it matters anymore) came up short again in Game 11 by 10 points (15).

The Hawkeyes Points Differential increased by 2 to +314 over the last 44 games.

Notes:

In the 11th game of the 2023 Season, Iowa’s Offense scored 2 touchdowns (1 pass + 1 rush) — season total is now 19 Offensive Touchdowns and the average has increased to 1.73 Offensive Touchdowns per game.

In the 13 games of the 2022-23 Season, Iowa’s Offense scored 19 touchdowns, averaging 1.46 Offensive Touchdowns per game. In the last 8 games of the 2021-22 Season, Iowa’s Offense scored 11 touchdowns, averaging 1.38 Offensive Touchdowns per game. That is an average of 1.43 Offensive touchdowns per game over those 21 games. Including the 11 games so far in the 2023 Season, Iowa’s Offense has scored a total of 49 touchdowns, and the average over those 32 games is 1.53 touchdowns per game.
