

Iowa Football — Offense Trends + Notes — 2021-2023

Trends:

The Hawkeyes are now 70-8 when rushing for 100 yards or more in a game over the past 8 seasons - and 11-25 when failing to do that (35 net rush yards vs. Michigan). The Hawkeyes are also 50-5 when scoring 20 or more points in a game since the start of the 2017 Season - and just 10-22 when scoring less than 20 points (0 points vs. Michigan).

Points:

The season total remains at 201 points and the average decreased to 15.46 points per game — the team has failed to reach or surpass the 25 point mark 11 times in its 13 games (Michigan 26 - Iowa 0). The 2023 “Drive to 25” (doesn’t matter anymore) came up short again in Game 13 by 25 points (0).

The Hawkeyes Points Differential decreased by 26 to +291 over the last 46 games.

Notes:

In the 13th game of the 2023 Season, Iowa’s Offense scored no touchdowns (0 pass + 0 rush) — season total is now 20 Offensive Touchdowns and the average has decreased to 1.54 Offensive Touchdowns per game.

In the 13 games of the 2022-23 Season, Iowa’s Offense scored 19 touchdowns, averaging 1.46 Offensive Touchdowns per game. In the last 8 games of the 2021-22 Season, Iowa’s Offense scored 11 touchdowns, averaging 1.38 Offensive Touchdowns per game. That is an average of 1.43 Offensive touchdowns per game over those 21 games. Including the 13 games so far in the 2023 Season, Iowa’s Offense has scored a total of 50 touchdowns, and the average over those 34 games is only 1.47 touchdowns per game.
