- 1. lowa State (1-0, 0-0 Big 12) plays host to lowa (1-0, 0-0 Big Ten) in the annual lowa Corn Cy-Hawk Series showdown between the state's largest public universities.
- 2. This year's game marks the 40th anniversary of the renewal of the series. The ISU-lowarivalry went dormant from 1935-76 until the series was revived in 1977. Both school's signed contracts to extend the series to at least 2023.
- 3. lowa currently leads this season's lowa Corn Cy-Hawk series competition (2-0) with a victory in soccer on Aug. 25. Volleyball will compete on Friday (2 points) and Saturday's football game is worth three points.
- lowa leads the all-time football series vs. lowa State at 42-22, but the Cyclones have won 10 of the last 19 games in the series.
- 5. lowa stopped a streak of four-straight games where the road team was victorious in the series with a 42-3 win in lowa City a year ago.
- 6. ISU's last win in the series was a 20-17 victory in lowa City in 2014. Cole Netten drilled a 42-yard game-winning FG in the closing seconds to secure the victory. ISU's last win over lowa in Ames was in 2011 in a 44-41 triple-overtime thriller. James White scored a walk-off, four-yard TD in the third OT.
- 7. ISU, which has had over 50,000 fans attend a game in Jack Trice Stadium for a school-record 40-straight games, played its first game (UNI) as a sellout on Saturday, tying the school's attendance mark (61,500).
- 8. Iowa State won its season-opener over UNI, ranked No. 18 in the FCS poll, 42-24.
- The Cyclone defense shined early, recording three first-half interceptions, including a pair returned for TDs.
 Willie Harvey had a 12-yard INT return for a TD and Kamari Cotton-Moya tallied his second career pick-six with
 a 22-yard INT return.
- 10. It was the first time ISU had a pair of pick-sixes in a game since 2010 (UNI) and the Cyclones have now recorded a non-offensive TD in three-straight games (TTU in 2016- Kamari Cotton-Moya, INT; WVU in 2016- Kene Nwangwu, KR; UNI in 2017- Cotton-Moya and Harvey, INT) for the first time since 2010.
- 11. From 2013-16, ISU recorded just one defensive TD in a 46-game stretch. ISU has tallied three defensive TDs in its last three games dating back to last season. ISU is one of five schools nationally (Florida, Texas, TCU, SMU) with a pair of defensive TDs in week one. ISU and Florida both had two pick-sixes.
- **12.** After a slow start, the Cyclone offense got rolling vs. UNI, recording 360 of their 405 yards of total offense in the final three quarters. ISU scored TDs on four of five possessions in the middle part of the game to take a commanding 42-17 lead in the fourth guarter.
- **13.** Preseason All-American WR Allen Lazard had a recording-setting night by tallying eight receptions for 108 yards. Lazard broke three ISU career receiving records in the game: career receptions (178), career 100-yard receiving games (9) and consecutive games with 100 receiving yards (4).
- **14.** Jacob Park was sharp, completing 77.1 pct. of his passes on a career-high 27 completions. He passed for 271 yards and a pair of TDs. He is averaging 309.0 YPG in his last three games dating back to last season.
- 15. Park's emergence at QB has helped the Cyclone offense average 524.7 yards of total offense in their last three games dating back to last season. Park's career 61.3 pct. completion rate and 140.7 career passer rating are both on pace to be ISU records.
- **16.** David Montgomery had two TDs and rambled for 82 yards on 14 carries. He's averaging 105.8 yards in his last four games dating back to last season.
- 17. Joel Lanning, who started 14 games at QB from 2015-16, had a successful night in his first start at LB with seven tackles. Lanning, who picked up a first down on his lone offensive play, became the first Cyclone to play on both offense and defense in the same game since Joe Woodley in 2002.

- First two lowa State recruiting classes ranked in the top-50 nationally.
- Campbell's .700 winning pct. at Toledo was third-best in school history behind Nick Saban and Bill Orwig.
- Two Toledo teams (2012 & 2015) cracked the nation's top-25.
- Defeated two ranked teams at Toledo (No. 18 Cincinnati in 2012; No. 18 Arkansas in 2015).

⇒IOWA CORN CY-HAWK SERIES

- This is the 14th season of the head-to-head all sports series between lowa State and lowa. The school that excels
 in competition athletic and academic will be crowned champion of the head-to-head series between the
 Cyclones and Hawkeyes.
- The series is now officially called the Iowa Corn Cy-Hawk Series.
- lowa currently leads this season's lowa Corn Cy-Hawk series competition (2-0) with a victory in soccer on Aug.
 25. Volleyball will compete on Friday (2 points) and Saturday's football game is worth three points.
- The all-time series is even at 6-6-1. ISU won or shared three-straight titles until lowa ended the streak last season.
- The winner of Saturday's football game will take home the Cy-Hawk Trophy, presented annually to the winner since 1977.

⇒ISU-IOWA TIDBITS

- lowa won 15-straight games in the series from 1983-1997. The Cyclones ended the streak in 1998 and have won 10 of the last 19 games in the series since the 1998 victory. lowa has won two-straight games in the series and two-straight games in Ames.
- lowa stopped a streak of four-straight games where the road team was victorious in the series with a 42-3 win in lowa City a year ago. ISU's last win vs. lowa in Ames was in 2011 in a 44-41triple overtime thriller. James White scored the walk-offTD on a four-yard run in the third overtime.
- lowa State freshman OL Sean Foster's father, Troy, was a member of the lowa football team from 1990-94.
- lowa State defensive GA Colby Kratch is the son of former lowa OL Bob Kratch, who was a two-time All-Big Ten selection (1986 and 1988) and an eight-year NFL veteran.
- lowa freshman PK Caleb Shudak's father, Jeff, was an All-Big Eight PK for lowa State from 1987-90.
- ISU senior WR Allen Lazard has 19 receptions and 235 receiving yards in his career vs. Iowa. He posted seven
 catches for 111 yards in last year's game vs. the Hawkeyes.

⇒IF YOU BUILD IT, THEY WILL COME

- lowa State has shattered virtually all attendance marks in this decade.
- Over 50,000 fans have attended a game in Jack Trice Stadium a school-record 40-straight games.
- Nine of the top-10 most attended games in school history have occurred since 2012.
- ISU sold out its first game at 61,500, equaling the school attendance mark (UNI, Iowa in 2015).

⇒IOWA STATE-UNI RECAP

- lowa State was victorious in its season-opener, rolling to a 42-24 win over UNI Saturday night.
- It was the most points for the Cyclones in a season-opener since scoring 44 vs. South Dakota State in 2008.
- A slow start by the offense was aided by the defense, as the Cyclones scored two-straight TDs on interception returns (Willie Harvey- 12 yards; Kamari Cotton-Moya- 22 yards) to take the lead for good at 14-7.
- It marked the first time since 2010 where ISU had a pair of pick-sixes in a game. It was Cotton-Moya's second interception return for a TD in his career (Texas Tech-2016).
- Brian Peavy also recorded an interception, his team-best fourth of his career, to help the Cyclones win the turnover battle for the fourth time in their last five games.
- After the defense jumpstarted the team, the offense got rolling by scoring TDs in four out of its next five possessions to take a commanding 42-17 lead before sending in the reserves.
- Cyclones recorded 360 of their 405 yards of total offense in the final three quarters.
- It was a record-setting night for Allen Lazard, who broke three Cyclone career marks in the victory. Lazard, who had eight catches for 108 yards on the night, is now ISU's all-time leader in career receptions (178), career 100-yard receiving games (9) and consecutive 100-yard receiving games (4).
- RB David Montgomery led the Cyclones on the ground with 82 yards and two TDs and QB Jacob Park was sharp by completing a career-high 27 passes on 35 attempts (77.1%) for 271 yards and two TDs.
- WR Hakeem Butler also had career highs in receptions (7) and receiving yards (75) and a TD.
- Peavy led the team with 10 tackles, his third career 10+ tackle game.

⇒NEWCOMERS HIT THE FIELD, EARN FIRST STARTS

- A total of 13 freshmen and one true freshman (Johnnie Lang) played in their first game vs. UNI: Lawrence White

⇒LAZARD RETURNS AS ONE OF THE NATION'S BEST RECEIVERS

- Allen Lazard has established himself as one of the premier wide receivers in the nation.
- Lazard, a First-Team All-Big 12 selection in 2016, is a member of the Biletnikoff Award Watch List and has made numerous preseason All-America teams.
- Lazard is targeting virtually every career receiving record in Cyclone history. He's already set four career records: Receptions (178), 100-yard receiving games (9), Consecutive 100-yard receiving games (4) and Consecutive games with a reception (36).
- Lazard needs 569 receiving yards to become ISU's all-time leader in that category.
- Lazard currently owns a school-record streak of four-straight 100-yard receiving games and has five 100-yard games in his last six contests dating back to last season, averaging 113.0 yards in that span.
- Among active FBS players, Lazard ranks second in career receptions (178), fourth in career receiving yards (2,527) and third in consecutive games with a reception (36).
- Lazard became just the fourth player in school history to record an 1,000-yard receiving season when he posted 1,018 yards in 2016.
- Lazard was also named a team captain for the second-straight season, joining his father, Kevin Lazard, as team
 captains at lowa State. Kevin was a co-captain of the 1993 lowa State football team.

⇒LANNING SWITCHES TO LB AND IS A TWO-WAY PLAYER

- One of ISU's biggest stories out of spring drills was the decision to move former QB Joel Lanning to linebacker for his senior season.
- Lanning started 14 games at QB throughout his career, recording 2,537 passing yards and 19 TDs with a completion percentage of 56.9.
- Lanning's value at QB was enhanced with his capability to run, especially in the "Lan Ram" package in shortyardage situations. He led the team with 11 rushing TDs and was third on the team in rushing yards (518) in 2016.
- Lanning tallied seven tackles vs. UNI in his first career start on defense and gained a yard in his only rush, becoming
 the first Cyclone since Joe Woodley (2002) to play on offense and defense in the same game.
- Lanning is not the first Cyclone QB to make a successful switch to LB. In 2000, Derrick Walker moved to LB after spending the 1999 season as ISU's backup QB. Walker was instrumental in helping ISU earn its first bowl berth in 22 years by recording 61 tackles in 10 starts on the 2000 Insight.com Bowl champion squad.

⇒JACOB PARK THRIVING AT OB

- Jacob Park has only started four games in his career, but is posting some of the best numbers by a Cyclone signalcaller in school history.
- Park currently owns ISU school records in completion percentage (61.3) and passer rating (140.7).
- He's already tossed a pair of 300-yard passing games, which ties for sixth in school history, and has six multi-TD games in his career.
- In his last three games, Park is averaging 309.0 yards passing.
- In the season-opener vs. UNI, Park completed 77.1 pct. of his passes and set a career best in completions with 27.

⇒DAVID MONTGOMERY HAVING OUTSTANDING START TO CAREER

- Sophomore David Montgomery took over the starting running back spot late in the 2016 season and has excelled.
- Montgomery led the Cyclones in rushing vs. UNI, gaining 82 yards on 14 carries (5.9 ypc). He missed the fourth quarter after suffering from leg cramps.
- Montgomery is averaging 105.8 yards in his last four games dating back to last season, racking up a pair of 100yard games in that span.
- His 563 rushing yards in 2016 led the Cyclones and was the second-best rookie total in school history.
- Montgomery is currently averaging 5.2 yards per carry in his young career, which is on pace to be one of the best clips in school history.
- He scored a pair of TDs in the season-opener vs. UNI, which is tied for the most in the Big 12.
- Montgomery was a QB in high school and was teammates with current Cyclone Deshaunte Jones in eighth grade while growing up in Cincinnati.

⇒TURNING THE TABLE ON TURNOVERS

- Winning the turnover margin is a key ingredient for successful football teams.
- The Cyclones have ended their last four seasons negative in the turnover margin, but showed signs of improvement at the end of the 2016 season and continued the trend this year.
- ISU had a 22-game stretch (2014-16) where it won the turnover margin just three times.
- However, ISU has forced more turnovers than its committed in four of its last five games dating back to last season at a +3 margin.
- ISU has a +2 turnover margin this season thanks to three interceptions in the season-opener vs. UNI.
- From 2013-16, ISU recorded just one defensive TD in a 46-game stretch. However, ISU has tallied three
 defensive TDs in its last three games dating back to last season.
- In the season-opener vs. UNI, the Cyclones recorded a pair of interception returns for a TD (Willie Harvey and Kamari Cotton-Moya)
- Cotton-Moya has two pick-sixes in his career.
- ISU and Florida were the only FBS schools nationally to have two INTTD returns after week one.

⇒EIGHT PLAYERS ON NATIONAL AWARD WATCH LISTS

- A total of eight Cyclones made watch lists for FWAA approved national awards in the preseason.
- This list includes WR Allen Lazard (Biletnikoff Award), OL Jake Campos (Wuerffel Trophy), DB Kamari Cotton-Moya (Jim Thorpe Award), P Colin Downing (Ray Guy Award), QB Jacob Park (Maxwell Award), RB David Montgomery (Doak Walker Award), WR/PR Trever Ryen (Paul Hornung Award) and OL Julian Good-Jones (Rimington Trophy).
- Sophomore DL Ray Lima is also on the Polynesian College Football Player of the Year Watch List and sophomore WR Hakeem Butler is on the Earl Campbell Tyler Rose Award Watch List.

- Lazard joined his father, Kevin, as a team captain. Kevin Lazard was a co-captain of the 1993 lowa State squad.
- Senior Jake Campos (OL) and juniors Jacob Park (QB) and Brian Peavy (CB) were also tabbed as leaders on the team.

⇒LARSON AND STARCEVICH PLACED ON SCHOLARSHIP

- Two former walk-ons, Kyle Starcevich (QB/H) and Bryan Larson (OL), were placed on scholarship prior to the season-opener.
- The pair join current Cyclones Jack Spreen (LB) and Trever Ryen (WR/PR) as former walk-ons who were placed on scholarship.
