@CYCLONEFB HEADLINES

- lowa State (1-0, 0-0 Big 12) plays host to #19 lowa (2-0, 1-0 Big Ten) in the annual lowa Corn Cy-Hawk Series showdown between the state's two largest public universities. The game, along with ISU's home-opener vs. UNI, is sold out.
- The two teams have met annually since 1977 after the series went dormant from 1935-76. Both school's signed contracts to extend the series to at least 2025. The teams will play for the lowa Corn Cy-Hawk Trophy.
- 3. lowa leads the all-time football series vs. lowa State at 44-22. In the last 21 years, lowa has the edge in the series at 11-10.
- lowa State was ranked in the AP-Top 25 in the first two weeks of the season, but barely fell out in Week 3. The Cyclones received 96 votes in this week's poll, the first team out of the top-25.
- 5. ISU has defeated a ranked lowa team one time in the series, defeating No. 8 lowa, 23-3 in Ames in 2005.
- 6. ISU has defeated five ranked teams since 2017 (5-4).
- ISU is riding a seven-game home winning streak (2018-6/2019-1), tying for the best string in school history. It ranks as the 15th-best active streak in FBS.
- Close games have been the norm in the last three Iowa State seasons. Iowa State, Oklahoma and Washington are the only "power 5" schools to avoid a loss of over 14 points in the last three seasons. ISU's worst loss since 2017 was a 24-10 setback at Texas in 2018.
- After beginning his ISU tenure at 1-8, head coach Matt Campbell has climbed above the .500 mark (20-19) for the first time in his Cyclone coaching career. He is 19-11 in the last 30 games.
- ISU has three wins over top-6 opponents since 2017 (2017: Oklahoma, TCU, 2018: West Virginia) to tie for second nationally behind only Alabama.
- lowa State didn't allow an offensive touchdown in regulation of its first game vs. UNI. The Cyclones allowed 11. just six offensive points before the game went into overtime.
- With just 34 yards rushing allowed, the Cyclones rank fifth nationally in rushing defense. ISU allowed just 1.1 ypr vs. UNI, the lowest total since 2005. ISU allowed just 229 yards in regulation.
- 13. ISU had 10.0 TFL in the UNI win, the sixth time since 2017 the Cyclones had double-digits in TFL in a game.
- Senior DE JaQuan Bailey needs one sack to become ISU's all-time career sack leader. He is currently tied for first with Shawn Moorehead (2004-06) with 18.5, the sixth-most by an active FBS player.
- ISU returns all five starters on its offensive line and had 114 combined career starts returning entering the season, the fifth-highest total among FBS teams: Oregon (153), Wake Forest (131), ULM (130), Texas Tech (116), Iowa State (114). All five starters are from Iowa.
- Senior WR Deshaunte Jones was outstanding in the season-opener vs. UNI, setting career highs in receptions (14) and receiving yards (126). His 14 catches ties for the most in FBS this year and is the second-best singlegame total in Cyclone history. He had 100 YAC in the first game.
- With 122 career receptions, Jones needs four catches to break into ISU's career top-10 in that category.
- Sophomore QB Brock Purdy threw for 278 yards and set a career high in completions with 30 vs. UNI, tying for the 10th-best single-game total in school history.
- Purdy has the best career completion pct. (67.4) in school history and has accounted for 23 of ISU's last 38 TDs in its last 10 games (18 passing, 5 rushing).
- Sophomore linebackers Mike Rose and O'Rien Vance had strong games vs. UNI. Rose had 3.5 TFL to lead the nation in TFL per game and Vance had 2.0 sacks to tie for second nationally in sacks per game.

⇒IOWA CORN CY-HAWK SERIES

- This is the 16th season of the head-to-head all sports series between lowa State and lowa. The school that excels in athletic competition will be crowned champion of the head-to-head series between the Cyclones and Hawkeyes.
- The series is now officially called the lowa Corn Cy-Hawk Series.
- The all-time series is at 7-7-1. ISU won or shared four of the last six titles.
- The winner of Saturday's football game will take home the lowa Corn Cy-Hawk Trophy, presented annually to the winner since 1977.

⇒ISU-IOWA TIDBITS

- lowa leads the all-time series at 44-22. The two in-state rivals didn't play from 1935-76 until resuming the annual series in 1977. The teams extended the series contract through 2025 in July.
- lowa won 15-straight games in the series from 1983-1997. The Cyclones ended the streak in 1998 and the series is slightly in favor of lowa (11-10) since. lowa has won four-straight games in the series.
- lowa State's last win in the series was in 2014 when Cole Netten kicked the game-winning FG with 0:02 seconds left for a 20-17 Cyclone win in lowa City.
- lowa State junior OL Sean Foster's father, Troy, was a member of the lowa football team from 1990-94.
- lowa State assistant director of scouting Colby Kratch is the son of former lowa OL Bob Kratch, who was a two-time All-Big Ten selection (1986 and 1988) and an eight-year NFL veteran.
- lowa PK Caleb Shudak's father, Jeff, was an All-Big Eight PK for lowa State from 1987-90.
- lowa hasn't committed a turnover in the series since a fumble in the fourth quarter in 2015.
- lowa State has defeated a ranked lowa team one time in the series, beating No. 8 lowa, 23-3 in Ames in 2005.

⇒IOWA STATE VS. RANKED OPPONENTS

- lowa State is 5-4 vs. ranked opponents since 2017.
- lowa State has a 22-188-2 all-time overall record vs. ranked opponents and a 13-88-1 mark vs. ranked opponents at home.
- lowa State ended a 20-game losing streak to ranked opponents with a 38-31 win at No. 3 Oklahoma in 2017.
 The Cyclones are 5-4 vs. ranked opponents since with wins over Oklahoma, TCU, Memphis, Oklahoma State and West Virginia.
- ISU head coach Matt Campbell is 7-12 vs. ranked opponents in his head coaching career (5-8 at ISU).
- Campbell owns 22.7 pct. (5 of 22) of ISU's all-time wins over ranked opponents, 33.3 pct. (3 of 9) of ISU's all-time victories over ranked opponents on the road and 75.0 pct. (3 of 4) of ISU's all-time triumphs over top-6 rated teams.

⇒IOWA STATE IN THE RANKINGS

- lowa State was the first team out of the AP Top-25 with 96 votes in this week's poll.
- ISU was ranked in the preseason AP poll for the first time since 1978.
- ISU has appeared in the AP Top-25 in each of the last three seasons for a total of 10 weeks.
- ISU was ranked in the AP Top-25 poll for five-straight weeks during the 2018 season, the fourth-best string in school history: 2002 (7-straight), 1972 (7-straight), 1978 (6-straight), 2018 (5-straight).
- ISU appeared in the CFP rankings in each of the prior two seasons. ISU was rated in eight of 12 CFP rankings in the last two seasons (2017-18), second only to Oklahoma (12) in the Big 12.
- ISU has an 18-22-2 overall record as a ranked team, including a 14-4-1 mark at home and 12-3 record at Jack Trice Stadium.

⇒UNI RECAP

- lowa State hung on to defeat FCS opponent UNI, 29-26 in triple overtime in its season-opener.
- The Cyclones outgained the Panthers, ranked No. 18 in FCS, by over 200 yards (463-262).
- The ISU defense didn't allow a touchdown in regulation and held UNI to just 229 yards of offense, including just 37
 rushing yards, before the overtime sessions.
- A Brock Purdy fumble which was returned 53 yards for a touchdown allowed the Panthers to stay in the game.
- The first OT period was settled with a pair of field goals and the second OT had both teams score touchdowns.
- UNI hit a field goal to open the third overtime and the Cyclones secured the victory with a Sheldon Croney 1-yard TD run.
- On the play before the winning touchdown, Croney fumbled, but Purdy dove in for the recover to keep the game alive.
- Purdy finished the game with a career-high 30 completions, tying for the 10th-best single-game total in ISU

history, and 278 yards. He also had two TD tosses.

- His favorite target was Deshaunte Jones, who set a career high in receptions (14) and receiving yards (126). His 14
 receptions is the second-best single-game total in ISU history.
- Graduate transfer La'Michael Pettway made a solid debut by catching three passes, two of them for TDs.
- Sheldon Croney had 56 rushing yards in the game, but all of the yards came in the fourth quarter and overtime periods. His TD rush sealed the victory.
- The defense was led by its linebacker crew of Marcel Spears, Mike Rose and O'Rien Vance. Spears had a team-high
 nine tackles and Vance had a career-high two sacks and eight stops. Rose tallied eight tackles and a career-high
 3.5 TFL
- The win was ISU's seventh-straight at Jack Trice Stadium, tying the modern era school record. ISU is now 4-0 in triple overtime games.

⇒CAMPBELL ONE OF ISU'S BEST COACHES

- Head coach Matt Campbell continues to get better in his fourth season as the Cyclone skipper.
- Campbell has a 20-19 overall record for a .513 winning percentage.
- In the modern era (1920-present) Campbell is one of two coaches in school history to maintain an above-.500 winning percentage.
- Campbell began his ISU career with an 1-8 mark and has a 19-11 record since.

⇒HOME COOKING

- lowa State won six games at home in 2018 to tie the school record for most victories on its home field in a season.
- After dropping its first home game to No. 5 Oklahoma, the Cyclones won their final six games at MidAmerican Energy Field at Jack Trice Stadium.
- ISU's current seven-game home-field winning streak ties for the best string in the modern era.
- ISU's streak is currently ranked 15th nationally. Alabama is No. 1 with 27 home wins in a row.
- The Cyclones have also won four-straight games at home vs. conference opponents, tying a school record.
- ISU trailed in the third quarter in its last three home wins (Kansas State, Drake, UNI).

⇒TEAM QUICK FACTS

- lowa State has trailed in the second half in seven of its 17 victories since 2017.
- lowa State has trailed in the fourth quarter in its last three home games, all victories.
- lowa State's margin of defeat in its 10 losses since 2017 is 6.4. ISU's worst loss in that span is 14 points (Texas, 24-10 in 2018). Only three "power 5" schools since 2017 have avoided a loss of over 14 points (lowa State, Oklahoma, Washington).
- In their last four games, the Cyclones are outgaining their opponents by an average of 112.0 yards per game.
- lowa State was ranked in the preseason AP poll for the first time since 1978.
- lowa State has lost the turnover margin in its last five games (11-4) despite going 3-2 in those games.
- lowa State has 11 players on its roster who have already earned their undergraduate degrees.
- Matt Campbell owns three of lowa State's nine all-time wins over ranked opponents on the road.

⇒DEFENSIVE NOTES

- The improvement of the Cyclone defense since 2017 is simply amazing. With the ability to use multiple formations
 without substitutions, ISU DC Jon Heacock has created a defensive master plan that other teams have mimicked.
- In the last 22 games, only five teams have scored more than 24 offensive points (Oklahoma State-2, Oklahoma, Kansas State, Washington State) vs. the Cyclones.
- lowa State's defense hasn't allowed an offensive point in the fourth quarter in 11 of its last 22 games (79), allowing
 an average of 3.6 points in the final quarter during that span.
- lowa State was third in the Big 12 and 39th nationally in sacks per game (2.5) in 2018, breaking the school record
 for sacks in a season with 33. The Cyclones had 16 different players credited with a sack a year ago.

- ISU led the Big 12 in scoring defense (22.9) 37th nationally and was second in total defense (349.2) 33rd nationally in 2018.
- ISU was also the Big 12 leader in rushing defense (115.0) 14th nationally in 2018. In its first game vs. UNI, the
 Cyclones gave up only 34 rushing yards vs. UNI to currently lead the nation in rushing defense.
- ISU held UNI to 1.1 yards per rush (31 carries for 34 yards), the lowest opponent ypr average since 2005.
- lowa State has held nine opponents to below 100 yards rushing since 2017 (27 games).
- Since 1985, lowa State has had 11 games with six or more sacks. Heacock and his defense have accounted for four of those games in the last three seasons.
- In its first game vs. UNI, the Cyclones didn't allow a TD in regulation and only six offensive points.
- In regulation, the Cyclones are allowing just 6.0 ppg, 229 total yards and 37 rushing yards.
- The Cyclones had 10.0 TFL vs. UNI. It was the sixth time since 2017 ISU has had 10.0 or more TFL in a game.

- The lowa State offense has been efficient since QB Brock Purdy took over signal-calling duties.
- Purdy is 8-2 as the Cyclone QB and the offense has thrived.
- In the last 10 games, the Cyclones are averaging 408.8 yards of total offense (4,088), 30.7 points (307) and 6.1 yards per play.
- ISU has recorded over 400 yards of total offense six times in the last 10 games.
- In its last four games, the Cyclones have outgained their opponents by 448 yards at a 112.0 yards per game clip
 difference.
- lowa State outgained UNI in the season-opener, 463-262.
