THE LEAD

Iowa State hosts Iowa in a sold out Iowa Corn Cy-Hawk Series showdown. The Cyclones are looking for their first win against Iowa at Jack Trice Stadium since 2011, as well as their first back-to-back wins against the Hawks since 2011-12.

KEY STORYLINES

- Iowa State meets Iowa for the 70th time Saturday afternoon as it tries for a 2-0 start for the second consecutive season.
- In his eighth season leading the program, Matt Campbell is tied for the third-longest tenured coach in program history with Jim Walden ... only Dan McCarney (12 seasons, 1995-2006) and Clay Stapleton (10, 1958-67) served the school longer.
- Iowa State opened the season with a workmanlike 30-9 win against UNI. The Cyclones never trailed in the game thanks in part to a defensive unit that jumped all over the Panthers, starting with Jeremiah Cooper's 58-yard INT return on UNI's opening possession ... the sophomore had two interceptions, the other being returned 30 yards and setting up a 56-yard field goal on the half's final play ... on Monday, he was named Big 12 Defensive Player of the Week.
- Iowa State's defensive unit allowed just 3.9 yards per play ... the defense owns a streak of 16 consecutive games holding its opponent to fewer than 400 yards of total offense, the nation's longest streak.
- Rocco Becht made his first career start at QB for the Cyclones and proved very efficient ... he was 10-for-13 passing for 113 yards and two touchdowns, while also rushing for another ... dating back to 1999, he's the first Cyclone QB to have at least two passing TD's and a rushing TD in his starting debut.
- ISU's offense ran just 45 plays, the fewest in FBS this season by a winning team.
- Kicker Chase Contreras booted the 56-yarder before the half ... it was the longest field goal attempted of the Matt Campbell era and the first 55+ FG made by a Cyclone at Jack Trice Stadium since 2010 (Grant Mahoney vs. Nebraska).

- Tied for second-longest tenured coach in Big 12 ... tied for third-longest tenured coach in school history.
- Owns second-best career winning pct. in ISU history at .528 (since 1928).
- Led ISU to a first-place finish in the final regular-season league standings (2020, 8-1) for the first time in school history.
- Only coach in school history to defeat every league team at home and on the road (new members not included).
- Set school record for conference wins (8-1) and tied school record for overall wins (9-3) in 2020.
- Owns 37.0 pct. of ISU's all-time wins over ranked opponents. Campbell has 10 wins vs. rated foes at Iowa State.
- Led ISU to first-ever New Year's Six Bowl win over Oregon in the 2021 Fiesta Bowl.
- Only coach in school history with five-straight winning seasons (2017-21).
- Owns five of ISU's six winning conference seasons in Big 12 history.
- His 32 Big 12 wins are the most by a Cyclone coach vs. conference teams.
- Member of five Division III national championships as a player and coach at perennial power Mt. Union (Ohio).
- Two-time All-American (d-line) and Academic All-American at Mt. Union ... 2022 CoSIDA Academic All-America Hall of Fame inductee.

MIDAMERICAN ENERGY FIELD AT JACK TRICE STADIUM/STARK PERFORMANCE CENTER



MIDAMERICAN ENERGY FIELD AT JACK TRICE STADIUM

MidAmerican Energy Field at Jack Trice Stadium has proven to be one of the nation's most outstanding football structures and is now in its 49 year existence. With its remarkable sight lines and numerous renovations throughout the years to enhance the game day atmosphere, the stadium ranks as one of the nation's best football venues.

The 61,500-seat stadium is the fourth-largest in the Big 12 Conference. Construction on the stadium started on Oct. 26, 1973, with the first game in the facility played on Sept. 20, 1975, a 17-12 Cyclone win over Air Force. It was officially dedicated as Jack Trice Stadium in 1997 in honor of Jack Trice, Iowa State's first African-American student-athlete who died tragically from injuries sustained in a football game in 1923. Iowa State is the nation's only FBS school to have a stadium name dedicated to an African-American.



WHO WAS JACK TRICE?

Jack Trice was born in Hiram, Ohio, in 1902. Trice attended East Tech High School in Cleveland, where he was a star athlete. When his football coach, Sam Willaman, was named head coach at Iowa State, Trice and six other athletes followed him west, as Trice became the first African-American student-athlete in Iowa State history. Trice majored in animal husbandry and his goal was to settle in the South after his graduation and help the black farmers of that area. He was a very studious young man and despite his participation in intercollegiate athletics, Trice managed to pass 45 college credits with a 90 percent

average. Because there were no athletic scholarships granted in those days, he worked odd jobs to finance his education and support his wife and mother.

On the gridiron, Trice was a stellar performer in the interior line in 1923. His promising career abruptly ended, however. Trice played in ISU's season-opener, a 14-6 win over Simpson in Ames. He traveled to Minneapolis the following weekend to face a strong Gopher squad. It was during intermission that Trice began to complain of a sore left shoulder, but nevertheless, returned to action in the second half. Midway through the third quarter, a frustrated Minnesota team ran a play off left tackle. Trice immediately saw that he wouldn't be able to reach the ball carrier, so he threw himself in front of the Minnesota interference in a roll block. He was toppled over on his back and trampled on.

Trice wanted to continue playing but never returned to the game. Doctors at a Minneapolis hospital allowed Trice to return to Ames with the team, which lost the game 20-17. They declared his condition not so serious. Trice rode back on a pullman coach. He rested his body on a straw mattress and was immediately taken to the university hospital upon his arrival in Ames. There, doctors discovered a broken collarbone Trice had sustained during the first half of the contest. His condition worsened as he developed respiratory problems Sunday afternoon, and a stomach specialist from Des Moines was summoned. Dr. Oliver Fay decided that surgery would be too risky, so no operation was performed.

At 3 p.m. on Monday, Oct. 8, 1923, Jack Trice died of hemorrhaged lungs and internal bleeding throughout the abdomen. The following Tuesday, classes were postponed and a funeral service was held before 4,000 students and faculty members on the central grounds of campus.

A letter written by Jack Trice to himself on the eve of the Minnesota game was found in his coat pocket the day of his funeral. The contents of that letter were divulged before the 4,000 mourners. It read:

"My thoughts just before the first real college game of my life: The honor of my race, family and self is at stake. Everyone is expecting me to do big things. I will. My whole body and soul are to be thrown recklessly about the field. Every time the ball is snapped, I will be trying to do more than my part. Fight low, with your eyes open and toward the play. Watch out for crossbucks and reverse end runs. Be on your toes every minute if you expect to make good. Jack."

A memorial scholarship was created, and a memorial to Trice is located on the east concourse of the football stadium as you enter the Jack Trice Club. A statue in his honor was unveiled in 1987 and currently resides on central campus, and a second statue was installed in front of the stadium in the fall of 2022.

Iowa State unveiled its new stadium in 1975 and it was originally named Cyclone Stadium. Gradually, the Trice story started to become more prevalent.

A strong push from students and alumni to dedicate the stadium in honor of Trice gained traction in the early 1980s. Iowa State President Dr. Robert Parks announced the facility name would change to Cyclone Stadium at Jack Trice Field prior to the 1984 season.

A groundswell of support for Trice continued, however. Supporters felt Trice's name should be the primary focus of the stadium. Finally, in 1997, President Dr. Martin Jischke officially dedicated Iowa State's football venue as Jack Trice Stadium, ahead of the season-opener against Oklahoma State.

STARK PERFORMANCE CENTER/BERGSTROM FB COMPLEX

The visual landscape surrounding Jack Trice Stadium was amplified with the addition of the Stark Performance Center, a \$90 million project connecting to the existing Bergstrom Football Complex and debuting in 2021. This massive upgrade created multiple spaces for use by all student-athletes, as well as the addition of the Albaugh Family Plaza north of Jack Trice Stadium for all Cyclones to enjoy.

New or upgraded amenities include: football locker room, football player's lounge, nutrition center, sports medicine center, football offices, student-athlete life skills center, student-athlete academic center and student-athlete dining hall.

LAST TIME OUT

- Iowa State opened the season with a win for the third consecutive year, dismantling a UNI team that had played them close in years past with a 30-9 win.
- The Cyclone defense was the story with the top unit not allowing a touchdown ... overall, UNI managed 279 yards and outgained the Cyclones by 29 yards, but the Panthers ran 27 more plays thanks to short fields for ISU's offense.
- ISU ran just 45 plays in the game, the fewest by a Cyclone team since running 45 at Oklahoma in 2022 and the fewest in a win since running 37 vs. Oklahoma State in 1961.
- Jeremiah Cooper's season-opening score on a 58-yard interception return was ISU's first for a touchdown since 2021 (Jake Hummel) ... he finished the game with two picks, becoming the first Cyclone to do so in a game since Marcel Spears against Texas Tech in 2018.
- The Cyclones had five sacks, one from the defensive line, three from the linebacker position and one from cornerback ... walk-on linebacker Caleb Bacon had the first two sacks of his career ... linebacker Will McGlaughlin added a sack, while defensive lineman Trent Jones and corner Myles Purchase had their first career sacks.
- Purchase and defensive lineman Tyler Onyedim led the squad with seven tackles each ... Onyedim was a disruptive force up front in his first career start.
- On offense, Rocco Becht (10-13, 113 yards, 2 TDs) made his first career start ... true freshman JJ Kohl (4-5) also saw action.
- Kicker Chase Contreras made his Cyclone debut and saw his first action since 2021 at Nebraska ... he made a splash with a 56-yard field goal as time expired in the first half, while also knocking through all three PATs.
- Freshman tight end Benjamin Brahmer made his first career catch a memorable one, grabbing a 36-yard TD pass from Becht in the third quarter.
- RS sophomore TE Tyler Moore also had a score (14-yarder from Becht) as Cyclone tight ends combined for seven catches for 81 yards.
- The Cyclones led 23-0 at the half and improved to 36-5 when leading at the break under Campbell.
- ISU started 10 redshirt sophomores or younger, including true freshman linebacker Jack Sadowsky.

FROM THE NOTEBOOK

SPECIAL TEAMS

- Iowa State had a really strong special teams performance in week one against UNI ... new special teams coach Jordan Langs is leading the way with all other coaches heavily influencing the units.
- In 2022, ISU was the only program in the nation to start true freshman specialists at kicker (Jace Gilbert) and punter (Tyler Perkins).
- Perkins earned the starting spot again this season and punted eight times for an average of 53.6 yards per punt, dropping two inside the 20 ... his first punt of the season was a booming, career-long 70 yarder that was downed at the UNI 2-yard line by Darien Porter ... the 70-yard boot was ISU's longest punt since 2010 (Kirby Van Der Kamp) ... he leads the Big 12 and ranks second nationally in yards per punt.
- Nebraska transfer Chase Contreras earned the starting placekicker duties and knocked through a 56-yard field goal to end the first half ... he was also 3-for-3 on PATs ... the 56-yard field goal was the longest of his career by 17 yards ... it was the fifth-longest FG in school history.
- Jaylin Noel had 60 punt return yards for the Cyclones after ISU had just 87 yards a season ago as a team ... his long return of 39 yards was Iowa State's longest since 2018.

REMEMBERING JACK TRICE

- Iowa State will spend the 2023 season honoring the legacy of Jack Trice, who was the school's first Black student-athlete ... Trice died tragically from injuries suffered in his second football game in 1923 ... he passed away on Oct. 8, 1923.
- Among the things Iowa State will do to remember Trice this season, the Oct. 7 game against TCU will be the Jack Trice Legacy game. The Cyclones will wear throwback jerseys for the game and the weekend will include a memorial service on central campus similar to the one held in 1923 following his passing.
- Trice is remembered at Iowa State in many ways, including: statue on campus, Breaking Barriers sculpture outside Jack Trice Stadium, the Jack Trice Club inside the stadium, street in front of stadium was changed to Jack Trice Way in fall of 2022.
- For the fifth-straight season, Iowa State will honor its past and raise awareness of social injustice issues by wearing patches dedicated to Jack Trice ... the patch design is similar to the jersey Trice

wore during his Iowa State career.

- Gerry Vaughn is the second recipient of the Jack Trice Endowed Scholarship.

COACHING STAFF UPDATE

- ISU's coaching had a bit of a makeover after last season. The most significant change comes at offensive coordinator where Nate Scheelhaase slides in after coaching running backs and wide receivers last season. Scheelhaase is in his sixth season with the program.
- Also coming on staff are offensive line coach Ryan Clanton, running backs coach/special teams coordinator Jordan Langs, wide receiver coach Noah Pauley and cornerbacks coach Hank Poteat.
- While Scheelhaase is a first-time coordinator, he's got plenty of experience around him on that side of the ball ... Clanton (UNI) and Pauley (NDSU/Minnesota-Duluth) are former offensive coordinators, while Langs joins the group after a head coaching stint at NAIA Indiana Wesleyan where he started the program and last year led them to the NAIA FCS Semifinals ... tight end coach Taylor Mouser is in his eighth season at ISU.
- The defensive coaching staff remained largely intact with Poteat the only addition ... a former assistant at Wisconsin, Poteat is a Super Bowl winner with 10 years of NFL experience.

THE QB ROOM

- Iowa State's QB room has talent, but not a lot of experience.
- On the active roster, only redshirt freshman Rocco Becht has taken snaps at the Division I level ... Becht played in three games last season with 15 pass attempts, 13 of which came in the season finale at TCU ... Becht's father, Anthony, played at West Virginia and was a first-round pick in 2000 on his way to playing 12 years in the NFL at tight end for five teams ... Anthony is currently the head coach of the XFL's St. Louis Battlehawks.
- Freshman JJ Kohl comes in as a consensus four-star recruit ... the 6-7 signal caller hails from 30 minutes down the road in Ankeny ... his father, Jamie, was a kicker at ISU from 1995-98 and runs the renowned Kohl's Professional Camps.
- Rounding out the scholarship players is JUCO QB Tanner Hughes, who played at the same high school (Pleasant Valley) and junior college (Butte College) as Aaron Rodgers ... his dad, brother and uncle were all Division I quarterbacks.

- ISU will have to replace Xavier Hutchinson's record-setting production (school-record 107 receptions in 2022 and 254 career catches).
- Among the candidates to lead the way are Jaylin Noel, who has 103 receptions in 26 games.

- The Cyclones added Eastern Kentucky transfer Jayden Higgins, who brings great size (6-4) and production (87 receptions, 1,151 yards, 13 TDs) in two seasons for the Colonels.

ON THE O-LINE

- The Cyclone offensive line had 86 career starts (fourth most among Big 12 teams) entering the season, led by 35 from Darrell Simmons and 20 from Jarrod Hufford ... Hufford is on the Outland Trophy Watch List.
- Center Jim Bonifas and left tackle James Neal made their first career starts for the Cyclones in the opener ... Neal is still relatively new to the game of football, only starting to play his senior year of high school before attending Independence CC for one season.
- The group should benefit from the addition of new offensive line coach Ryan Clanton, who coached two UNI O-linemen to top-three round NFL Draft picks.

THE D-LINE

- ISU has to replace its entire starting defensive line, which included first-round NFL pick and Big 12 career sacks leader Will McDonald IV (NY Jets).
- In game one, ISU started Tyler Onyedim (R-So.), who had a team-high seven tackles ... Joey Petersen started at the other end spot ... Petersen comes from a long line of Cyclones, including brother Zach (2018-21), father and two-time All-Big Eight DL Troy (1991-94) and younger brother AJ, who is currently a freshman TE on the team ... in the middle, sophomore Domonique Orange opened the game drilling UNI's quarterback and setting the tone for the game.

PUMPED UP

- Iowa State's strength and conditioning program is under the direction of new coach Reid Kagy ... Kagy, who was on staff as an assistant from 2016-18, came to the

Cyclones from Boise State after a stop at Oregon.

- Campbell and his staff have raved about the gains the program has made physically under Kagy and his staff.
- The average gains made on the roster this offseason was eight pounds per man.

ISU VS. RANKED OPPONENTS

- Iowa State is 10-16 vs. ranked opponents since 2017 ... the Cyclones have beaten at least one ranked team five of the last six seasons.
- ISU head coach Matt Campbell is 12-24 vs. ranked opponents in his head coaching career, including a 10-20 mark with the Cyclones.
- Campbell owns 37.0 pct. (10-of-27) of ISU's all-time wins over rated opponents, 40.0 pct. (4-of-10) of ISU's all-time wins over ranked foes on the road and 75.0 pct. (3-of-4) of the school's all-time victories against Top 6 rated teams.
- Campbell is 4-5 vs. Top 10 opponents at ISU. The Cyclones were 8-98-2 vs. Top 10 opponents prior to his arrival.

CAMPBELL IS ISU'S GREATEST COACH

- Head coach Matt Campbell, a three-time Big 12 Coach of the Year (2017, 2018, 2020) honoree, has turned Iowa State into a winner in his tenure.
- Campbell has a 47-42 overall record for a .528 winning percentage, the second-best winning percentage by a Cyclone coach since the Big Six was formed (1928) and the second-most wins in school history.
- Campbell began his ISU career with a 1-8 mark, but is 46-34 since.
- 27 of Campbell's 42 losses at Iowa State have been one-score games.
- Campbell is the only coach in school history to defeat every league team (excluding this year's additions) during their tenure and is 32-24 in regular-season conference games in the last 56 games.
- He has defeated every Big 12 school (excluding this year's additions) on the road and at home, both program firsts.
- Campbell's 32 league victories rank first in school history among Cyclone coaches.
- Campbell owns 32 of ISU's 76 all-time wins vs. Big 12 teams (42.1 pct.).
- ISU's Big 12 win season average from 1996-2015 (2.2). ISU's Big 12 win season average from 2016-present (4.6).
- Campbell is 14-11 coaching the Cyclones as a ranked team. The 25 games coached

as a ranked team are the most in school history.

- First coach in school history to defeat OU and Texas in the same season (2020).
- Led ISU to a first-place finish in the 2020 regular-season Big 12 standings at 8-1. It marked the first time in school history ISU ended the conference regular-season in sole possession of first place.
- In Big 12 history (1996-2021), ISU has had only six winning conference seasons. Campbell has produced five of them (2017-21).
- Posted two perfect home seasons vs. Big 12 competition (2020; 5-0; 2021; 4-0). ISU has had only four perfect home seasons vs. league competition in school history (1931, 2002).
- Won four conference coach of the year awards since 2015: 2015 (MAC-Toledo), 2017, 2018, 2020 (Big 12-Iowa State).

PROGRAM IMPROVEMENT SINCE 2017

- Iowa State has winning seasons in five of the last six years and reached bowl games in five of the last six seasons for the first time in school history (modern era, 1928-present).
- Iowa State has finished above .500 in conference play in five of the last six seasons for the first time in the modern era (1928-present) ... ISU has just six winning league seasons in the Big 12 era (2000, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021).
- Iowa State has finished fourth or better in the Big 12 standings in five of the last six seasons.
- Tallied 10 wins over AP Top 25 opponents since 2017 ... ISU has just 27 victories over AP Top 25 opponents in the 131 years of the program.
- Recorded four victories over teams rated in the nation's Top 10 since 2017.
- Tallied 10 victories since 2017 where ISU trailed or was tied in the fourth Q.

- Since 2018, Iowa State is 25-9 (.735) at Jack Trice Stadium.
- The Cyclones tied a school record for home wins in a season with six in 2018.
- Iowa State registered back-to-back perfect seasons at home vs. league opponents (2020: 5-0; 2021: 4-0).
- Iowa State has won 18 of its last 23 Big 12 games at Jack Trice Stadium.

BEATING THE BEST

- Iowa State has seen sustained success against ranked teams since 2017.
- Since 2017, Iowa State has 10 wins vs. Top 25 teams, four vs. Top 10 teams and four vs. Top 25 teams on the road.

ISU-IOWA NOTES

- The Cyclones and Hawkeyes meet for the 70th time in series history and 30th time in Ames ... ISU is looking for its first win against Iowa in Ames since 2011.
- Outside of the 2020 season when the game wasn't played due to Covid-19 scheduling, the two teams have met annually since 1977 after the series went dormant from 1935-76. The teams will play for the Iowa Corn Cy-Hawk Trophy.
- Iowa leads the all-time series vs. Iowa State, 46-23. In the last 24 years, Iowa has the edge in the series at 13-11.
- Iowa won 15-straight games in the series from 1983-1997. The Cyclones ended the streak in 1998 and the series is slightly in favor of Iowa (13-11) since.
- Iowa State's last home win in the series came in 2011 – a 44-41 triple overtime thriller ... running back James White scored the winning TD on an option play.
- After not turning the Hawkeyes over since 2015, ISU forced three turnovers (2 fumbles, 1 INT) in last season's win at Kinnick Stadium.
- ISU has held Iowa to less than 200 yards of total offense in the last two meetings (150 in 2022; 173 in 2021) ... the Hawkeyes have averaged just 2.9 yards per play against ISU the last two seasons.
- Iowa State has defeated a ranked Iowa team one time in the series, beating No. 8 Iowa, 23-3, in Ames in 2005.
- The two teams have met in September every season except in 2001 when the September 11 terrorist attacks forced the postponement and rescheduling of the game to November that season.

FROM THE NOTEBOOK

- Four of Iowa State's 12 all-time wins over Top 10 teams have occurred since 2017.
- Defeated a ranked team at home in five of the last six seasons.

KEEPING IT CLOSE

- With Matt Campbell at the helm, Iowa State has had a chance for victory every time it takes the field.
- Since 2017, ISU has been defeated by over 14 points just three times (Notre Dame in 2019, Louisiana in 2020, TCU in 2022).
- In 14 of 32 losses since 2017, ISU has led or was tied in the 4th quarter.
- ISU has played in 38 one-score games since 2017 with a 15-23 record.
- In the Campbell era (2016-present), ISU has played in 43 one-score games with a 16-27 record.
- 27 of Campbell's 42 losses at Iowa State were one-score games.
- 12 of ISU's last 14 Big 12 losses were one-score games and 19 of ISU's 25 losses vs. Big 12 teams since 2017 were by seven points or fewer.
- ISU has played in 21 games decided by three points or less in the Matt Campbell era (2016-present), going 8-13 in those games.
- The Cyclones have accumulated 10 victories since 2017 where the game was tied or ISU trailed in the 4th quarter.

ROAD WARRIORS

- From 2006-16, ISU was 12-47 on the road ... since 2017, ISU has a 15-17 record in road games.
- ISU has 11 road wins vs. conference opponents since 2017 ... ISU had four Big 12 road victories from 2012-16.
- Four of ISU's 10 all-time wins vs. ranked opponents on the road have occurred since 2017.

IF YOU BUILD IT, THEY WILL COME

- Iowa State has shattered virtually all attendance marks in this decade.

- Seven Cyclones have received their degrees already: Deshawn Hanika, Jarrod Hufford, Levi Hummel, Ben Nikkel, Jake Remsburg, Dimitri Stanley and Gerry Vaughn.

EXTRA SEASON

- Iowa State has two players who took their extra COVID season: linebacker Gerry Vaughn and wide receiver Dimitri Stanley.
- Vaughn started all 12 games last year and is in his sixth season at the school.
- Stanley is in his second season at ISU after transferring from Colorado.

CYCLONES IN THE NFL

- Just what has Matt Campbell done to the talent level at Iowa State in his time at the school? For the second consecutive season, Iowa State has 10 players on active 53-man rosters in the NFL, which matches the second-most in school history (non-replacement player season).
- In the 2023 NFL Draft, DE Will McDonald IV ended a 50-year first-round drought by being selected with the 15th pick by the New York Jets.
