## QUICK HITTERS

■ QB Asher O'Hara has led the Blue Raiders in rushing all three games this season.

■ MT has **14** total student-athletes playing the 2019 season with a degree in hand. That total ranks tied for 7th nationally.

■ WR Ty Lee has hauled in at least one reception in **43** straight games which equals the longest streak in MT history and is currently the longest in the nation. He will own the school mark if he catches a pass at Iowa.

■ LB Khalil Brooks has **15.0** career sacks which ranks tied for **14th** nationally among active players.

■ In MT's last **28** wins, it has averaged 506.9 yards of total offense and allowed 368.7.

■ MT is **33-15** all-time in C-USA play (does not include 2018 title game) and is averaging 193.5 yards rushing per game.

■ In their last 56 conference games, the Blue Raiders have a mark of **39-17**.

■ Over the last 86 games, the Blue Raiders have come up with 88 interceptions. They had 16 in 2018.

■ Consecutive Start Leaders: Malik Manziel (**21**), Khalil Brooks (**20**).

■ Under Rick Stockstill, the Blue Raiders have been involved in 23 games that were decided in the final minute of regulation or overtime. The team is 13-10 in those games and have won nine of the last 13.

■ Rick Stockstill is third on the school's all-time wins list with 88 victories.

■ In 168 games under Rick Stockstill, the

■ Middle Tennessee has scored 30 or more points 74 times under Rick Stockstill. The Blue Raiders had 10 games of 30 or more points in 2016 to set a new single-season high under Rick Stockstill. The previous mark was nine in 2009.

■ The 2019 season marks the first time MT has had two open dates since 2014.

■ MT has played in a school record **4** straight bowl games

■ MT has been bowl eligible 10 times in the last 13 years (7 straight years) and has reached a bowl game a school-record four straight years.

■ Middle Tennessee's 7-1 C-USA record in 2018 was its best since joining the league in 2013 and the seven league wins were the most since MT went 7-1 in 2009 (Sun Belt).

■ The 2019 season is the **105th** for Blue Raider football and the 21st at the FBS level.

■ From 2015 through 2019, Middle Tennessee

■ The Blue Raiders have done an excellent job this season of playing disciplined football. The team only has seven penalties in the last two games combined and 15 on the season to rank second in C-USA and **14th** nationally. MT has also not lost the turnover battle in a game this season.

## O'HARA OFF TO HOT START

■ One of the biggest question marks entering 2019 was the inexperience under center. After three games, so far so good. Asher O'Hara in his three starts has completed **70.8%** of his passes, averaged 261.7 yards through the air while adding eight TD passes and just two interceptions. His TD passes rank 27th nationally, while his passing efficiency mark of 170.0 ranks 22nd nationally.

## O'HARA MAKES HISTORY

■ QB Asher O'Hara, making just his second career start, made history for MT in the win over TSU on Sept. 7. The sophomore became the first player in school history to throw for at least 300 yards and run for at least 100 yards in the same game. O'Hara had a career-best 367 yards passing to go with 103 yards rushing. He is just the fourth QB in school history to record a 100-yard rushing game.

his first of the season and the **22nd** of his career. That ties him with Kerry Wright for second all-time in school history and brings him within one of tying the all-time mark of 23 set by Richie James. Lee also moved into third all-time in career receiving yards with **2,672**.

## BLANKENSHIP DOING IT ALL

■ Junior Reed Blankenship is off to a great start in 2019. He leads the team and ranks tied for 20th in C-USA with 25 total stops to go with a team-high two interceptions (ranks 7th nationally), a forced fumble and a blocked kick. He currently has eight career interceptions and needs just two more to tie for eighth all-time in MT history.

## RAIDERS ON TOP IN C-USA

■ Since 2016, Middle Tennessee has

16 C-USA wins to equal the most in the league. The Blue Raiders are 16-8 in that span and entered the year in sole first but has been tied this year as MT has not played a league game.

## 10 TIMES IN 13 YEARS

■ In 13 years under Rick Stockstill, Middle Tennessee has reached bowl eligibility 10 times and nine times in the last 10 years. The Blue Raiders have been bowl eligible under Stockstill in 2006, 2009, 2010, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018. The 10 bowl eligible years during the 13-year span is more than any FBS team in Tennessee and equals the most of any program in C-USA.

■ After four years with Brent Stockstill leading the offense, it will be time for someone else to take over the reins in 2019. The Blue Raiders return sophomores Asher O'Hara and Chase Cunningham to go with newcomer Randall Johnson. The Blue Raiders entered 2019 with just 21 total pass attempts from the quarterback position which ranked as the seventh fewest in the country behind Auburn (2), Penn State (7), NC State (7), Boise State (10), Fresno State (12) and Georgia Tech (17).

as the NCAA's active leader in career receptions with **225**. The next closest player behind Lee is SMU's James Proche with 217 career receptions. Lee has averaged 71 catches a season and if he does that in 2019 he will finish **8th** on the Conference USA's all-time receiving list. He also ranks fourth among active players in receiving yards with **2,672**.

## LEE ON PACE

■ Senior Ty Lee is on pace to own almost every receiving record at Middle Tennessee. The Moultrie, Ga., native currently ranks third all-time in receptions with **225**, third in yards with **2,672** and second in touchdowns with 22. He enters the Iowa game needing **20** receptions to own that mark, **590** yards for that record and just two more touchdown grabs to move to the top of that mark.

## BROOKS LEAVING HIS MARK

■ Senior Khalil Brooks has been a disruptive force during his career and his numbers back it up. Brooks currently stands fourth all-time at MT in quarterback sacks with **15.0** while also ranking fourth in tackles for loss with **35.0**. He needs 5.5 more sacks to move into fourth place and one TFL to move into third place in that category.

## GIANT KILLERS

■ Under Rick Stockstill, the Blue Raiders have a knack of knocking off Power 5 opponents. With the win at Syracuse in 2017, MT now has **five** wins over Power 5 foes in the Stockstill era. MT owns wins over Maryland (2008, 2009), Georgia Tech (2012), Missouri (2016) and Syracuse (2017) with six others begin decided by a touchdown or less.

## WINNING TURNOVER BATTLE

■ Winning the turnover battle is critical in collecting victories in football. Under Rick Stockstill, MT has a mark of **56-15** when winning the turnover battle and is **48-7** during bowl eligible years (2006, 2009, 2010, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018). Over the last **91** games (since 2012), MT is **31-4** when winning the turnover battle.

## LOOKING FOR 100

■ During its history, Middle Tennessee owns an impressive **173-55-1** (.757) record when a back gains 100 or more yards rushing. Under Rick Stockstill, a Blue Raider has reached the 100-yard mark 59 times and the team has a **51-8** mark in those games.

## MR. SENIORITY

■ Middle Tennessee head coach Rick Stockstill is in his 14th season at the helm of the Blue Raiders. His 14 seasons make him the longest tenured coach in Conference USA while ranking 6th nationally.

## OFFENSIVE NOTES

### 90 YARD DRIVES

■ The Blue Raiders have put together 26 scoring drives of 90 or more yards under Rick Stockstill. MT had four 90-yard-or-longer drives in 2016, none in 2017 and three in 2018. The longest drive under Stockstill was a 99-yarder in a 2007 win at Louisiana-Monroe.

■ Middle Tennessee's 80-yard touchdown pass against TSU equaled the seventh longest in school history and matched the longest under Tony Franklin.

■ DJ England-Chisolm hauled in an 80-yard TD reception in the second quarter against TSU which went down as the longest reception by a true freshman in MT football history. It was also tied for the seventh longest overall in school history and was the first touchdown of his young career.

■ Asher O'Hara's four touchdown passes against TSU matched the seventh most in MT history.

■ The Blue Raiders had 14 different players catch passes in the season opener at Michigan. That goes down as the most since MT hit 15 different players in the 2017 season opener against Alabama A&M.

■ MT has registered over 5,000 yards of total offense in a season nine times in its

history, and **seven** of those have come under Rick Stockstill, including the last four years in a row.

■ MT has topped the 200-yard rushing mark **10** times under Tony Franklin, including three games over 300 yards.

■ MT has gone over the 500-yard mark of total offense in a game **12** times under Tony Franklin. The Blue Raiders last did it against TSU in 2019 (604 yards).

■ In six years of C-USA action, MT has rushed for 9,291 yards in 48 league games. That averages out to 193.6 yards a game.

## DEFENSIVE NOTES

### DEFENSIVE SCORES

■ Under Rick Stockstill, the Blue Raider defense has scored **31** defensive touchdowns, and 26 have come since 2009. Of the 31 scores, 21 have been interceptions and 10 have come by way of fumble returns. The Raiders had four defensive scores in 2018.

### 18 TIMES UNDER SHAFER

■ Middle Tennessee's defense has held the opposition to under 400 yards of total offense in 18 of 30 games under Scott Shafer. MT did it nine times in 2017 and nine times in 2018. The Raiders only had four such games in 2016 prior to Shafer's arrival.

■ Under Scott Shafer, the Blue Raiders are averaging **34.0** sacks per season in two years.

■ MT owns two shutouts since entering C-USA play in 2013. MT defeated FIU 48-0 in 2013 and downed Alabama A&M in 2016, 55-0.

■ Overall, the Blue Raiders have **88** interceptions in their last 86 games. MT had 16 picks in 2018.

■ In 2018, the Blue Raiders held UAB to -1 total rushing yards in week 12. That went down as the third fewest ever allowed in a single game.

## SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

■ Junior PK Crews Holt equaled the school record in 2018 with 18 made field goals.





Middle Tennessee was recently named one of the best places to earn an undergraduate degree in the nation by The Princeton Review, which called it **"a go-to choice for those wishing to receive a quality and affordable education."**

He has **21** for his career and needs one more to tie for 10th on the all-time list.

■ Under Rick Stockstill, the Blue Raiders have blocked **42** kicks in 168 games (22 FGs, 15 punts, 5 PATs). MT has at least one blocked kick each year under Stockstill, including one this season.

### RAIDER ROUNDUP

■ The top-scoring quarter in the Rick Stockstill era is the second quarter. Here is a combined total for each quarter: 1st - 1,157 points; **2nd - 1,398 points**; 3rd - 921 points; 4th - 1,197 points; and 70 in overtime.

■ When both teams are held under 20 points, the Blue Raiders are **3-1** under Rick Stockstill.

■ As a FBS (I-A) member (247 games), the Raiders have scored **50** or more points **22** times.

■ The Blue Raiders are **93-15** in the FBS era when leading at the half and are **101-12** when leading a game entering the 4th quarter.

■ When trailing at the half, the Blue Raiders are just **22-100** in the FBS (I-A) era.

■ The Blue Raiders have scored in **81** consecutive games with the last shutout coming on Dec. 1, 2012 at Arkansas State (45-0). MT has also scored in **127** straight home games (last shutout was 9/23/1995 vs Murray State).

■ Largest margin of victory in the I-A era: 59 points vs Charlotte 9/19/15 (73-14) ... Largest margin of defeat in the I-A era: 59 points vs Oklahoma 9/23/06 (59-0).

### RAIDERS IN THE NFL

■ MT currently has five players on NFL rosters: Chandler Brewer (Rams), Kevin Byard (Titans), Darius Harris (Chiefs), Richie James (49ers) and Charvarius Ward (Chiefs).

### ACADEMICS ARE TOP PRIORITY

■ Academic success at MT has been a high priority for 14th-year coach Rick Stockstill. Under his reign, the Blue Raiders have seen **96** percent of student-athletes earn their degree entering the 2019 season. MT, who has also been impressive with APR scores under Stockstill, has been publicly recognized by the NCAA for APR success twice in the last nine years. Also under Stockstill, the Blue Raiders have taken home six Academic All-District honors and produced an Academic All-American.

Winning on the field, off the field and having a first-class football program from top to bottom is the goal of any university at the highest level of intercollegiate athletics. That is exactly what Middle Tennessee has as a result of the leadership of head coach Rick Stockstill.

In his 14th season at the helm of the Blue Raiders, Stockstill is the sixth-longest tenured coach in the country and third-longest in MT history. With his long tenure have come numerous achievements and accolades, including:

- Six-time Coach of the Year (2006 SBC, 2009 co-SBC, 2018 C-USA, 3-time TSWA)
- 2018 C-USA East Division champions
- 2006 Sun Belt co-champions
- 2009 New Orleans Bowl and 2017 Raycom Media Camellia Bowl champions
- 87 wins, 3rd all-time in program history
- Eight bowl appearances and bowl eligible 10 times
- Two NCAA awards for APR success (2011, 2012)
- American Football Coaches Association's 2017 Academic Achievement Award
- Back-to-back eight-win seasons in 2012-13 for first time in 21 years
- Four straight bowl appearances from 2015-18 for first time in program history
- Six of the top eight crowds in Floyd Stadium history, including top three
- Eight All-Americans, including one Academic All-American
- One overall conference player of the year and three defensive players of the year
- Produced 40 First Team All-Conference honors
- Four bowl game MVPs
- Six NFL Draft picks and a pro bowler
- Produced the school's all-time leader in passing yards, catches, sacks and interceptions

The leader of the Blue Raiders was crowned the 2018 C-USA Coach of the Year and the TSWA Coach of the Year after winning the East Division title and making the C-USA Championship game. MT advanced to the New Orleans Bowl for its school-record fourth straight post season appearance.

Stockstill and the Blue Raiders went to Montgomery, Alabama and took down Arkansas State for the Raycom Media Camellia Bowl championship in 2017, the first time in program history they played in bowl games in three successive seasons. It was also the seventh bowl game for MT under Stockstill's guidance and second win, joining the 2009 New Orleans Bowl title.

The first of the four-year bowl streak came in 2015, when MT held a 7-6 record and Popeyes Bahamas Bowl berth. The Blue Raiders had to show a tremendous amount of grit to become bowl eligible, winning all four games in November.

Prior to the three years finishing in bowl games, Stockstill led Middle Tennessee to three straight second-place finishes in the C-USA East Division from 2012-14, including a berth in the Bell Helicopter Armed Forces Bowl in 2013 against Navy.

Some regard the 2012 season as his best coaching job after leading the Blue Raiders to the nation's biggest win improvement from the previous year. They won just two games in 2011, but Stockstill turned the 2012 MT squad around, finishing with an 8-4 record that included an FBS school-record five road wins. They also received votes in the ESPN/USA Today Coaches Poll three straight weeks, another school record, and upset ACC Coastal Division Champion Georgia Tech. Along the way, he produced a Freshman All-American, eight all-conference players and a national offensive player of the week.

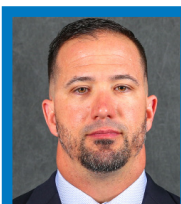

### ► Game Notes

• Middle Tennessee had nine first-time starters tonight against Michigan. The Blue Raiders had seven on offense and two on defense. Offensively, the first time starters were QB Asher O'Hara, WR Jarrin Pierce and OL Will Gilchrist, Eric Seay, Matt Martin, Marcus Greer and Robert Jones. On defense it was CB Desmond Anderson and LB Cody Smith.

• The announced crowd of 110,811 was the largest crowd to ever watch the Blue Raiders play in its 105-year history. The previous largest was 107,672 at Tennessee in 2002.

• Senior Khalil Brooks was credited with a half sack in the second quarter to run his career total to 15.0. That figure ties Anthony McCord for fourth all-time at MT. Brooks is now seventh all-time in tackle for loss yards (138), fourth all-time in sack yards (108), and tied for fourth all-time in career tackles for loss (34).

• Malik Mancel made his team-leading 19th straight start ... WR Ty Lee made his team-leading 37th career start ... WR Ty Lee has now caught at least one pass in 41 straight games ... All five starting offensive linemen made their first career Division I start against #7 Michigan ... WR Jarrin Pierce made his first touchdown grab as a Blue Raider ... QB Asher O'Hara, making his first career start under center, threw for a career-best 217 yards on a personal-best 22 completions ... DT Jordan Branch recorded his first career sack in the third quarter ... LB DQ Thomas turned in a career-high 10 tackles, including a personal high 8 solo stops.

## RAIDERS BATTLE BUT FALL AT #7 MICHIGAN

**ANN ARBOR** - The final score might not have been what they wanted, but Middle Tennessee put forth a valiant effort on the road against a top-10 ranked team.

The Blue Raiders (0-1) traveled to Michigan (1-0) to take on the No. 7 Wolverines, and though they lost 40-21, head coach Rick Stockstill saw plenty to draw some optimism out of the performance.

"I'm extremely proud of our team," the 14th-year head man said. "I thought we competed our tails off ... and we didn't back down and didn't flinch.

"We didn't play well enough to beat the No. 7 team in the country, but we did enough that if we clean up some mistakes we made and get a little better at some things, I think we have a chance to be a pretty good football team."

Middle Tennessee started a new era at quarterback, with redshirt sophomore Asher O'Hara making his first career start behind an offensive line with five new starters.

The Rolling Hills, Illinois native had a quality game against a defense that ranked second in the nation in passing yards allowed in 2018, connecting on 22-of-32 passes for 217 yards, two touchdowns and an interception. He also led the team with 32 rushing yards, and scored the season's first touchdown with a diving effort from 18 yards in the first quarter.

"It was really like just playing the game of football; the stage didn't really affect me that much," O'Hara said. "There were some good things and some bad things. I'm ready to go home and try to fix those for next week."

O'Hara's first-quarter score came off a Michigan fumble on its second play of the game, putting the Blue Raiders on top 7-0.

The Wolverines got on the board with a field goal five minutes later, then added a touchdown right before the quarter ended to bring a 10-7 score at the end of the first frame.

Middle Tennessee added its second touchdown after another Michigan fumble with five minutes left in the second quarter, but a Wolverines' field goal as time expired in the half gave the home team a 27-14 advantage.

Despite the score, Stockstill was pleased with how his defense played in the first half — most notably, forcing two turnovers — and he grew even happier after the break.

"For the first game, I thought we tackled well defensively," he said. "We gave up some big plays in the first half ... but I thought we were relentless."

The Blue Raiders' defensive intensity amplified after halftime.

They limited UM to just 75 yards in the third quarter, none coming through the air, and gave up only 13 points in the second half.

"I'm really happy about how we fought," junior linebacker DQ Thomas said. "Nobody threw in the towel ... I know there are some good things coming out of this team."

Thomas led the defense with 10 total tackles, and Desmond Anderson, Tyshun Render and Reed Blankenship each added seven. Redshirt freshman Jordan Branch had the first sack of his career, and seniors Trae Philpots and Khalil Brooks added half a sack apiece. Gregory Grate Jr. and Render both forced fumbles.

Offensively, senior Ty Lee caught four passes for 52 yards, moving two games away from tying Kendall Newson's program record of 43 straight games with a reception. Jimmy Marshall only caught one ball, but it went for a 59-yard touchdown late in the fourth quarter.

"There are a lot of positives I'll take out of this game with how we played," Stockstill said. "We've got the intangibles — we've got the toughness, the competitiveness, the effort. Now, if we can get a little better offensively, defensively and in the kicking game, we have a chance."

### ► Game Notes

- QB Asher O'Hara put his name in the record books in his first home game as a Blue Raider starter. O'Hara became the first player in school history to pass for over 300 yards and rush for more than 100 yards in the same game.
- DJ England-Chisolm hauled in an 80-yard touchdown reception in the second quarter which went down as the longest reception by a true freshman in MT football history. It was also tied for the seventh longest overall in school history and was the first touchdown of his young career.
- Junior Reed Blankenship notched the second two-interception game of his career when he brought in two against TSU. Blankenship also had two picks in the bowl game last year against Appalachian State so that gives him four picks in his last three games. Overall, Blankenship now has eight career interceptions and needs two more to tie for eighth all-time at MT.
- WR Ty Lee's 22-yard touchdown reception in the third quarter was his first of the season and the 22nd of his career. That ties him with Kerry Wright for second all-time in school history and brings him within one of tying the all-time mark of 23 set by Richie James. Lee also moved into third all-time in career receiving yards with 2,653.

## RAIDERS TAKE DOWN OLD RIVAL AT HOME

**MURFREESBORO** - It was hard to tell old Ohio Valley Conference rivals Middle Tennessee and Tennessee State hadn't played in 21 years when they met in Murfreesboro.

A well-fought affair ended with the Blue Raiders' first win of the season (1-1), 45-26, though the underdog FCS Tigers (1-1) kept things close all night in true rivalry fashion.

"I'm proud of our team," MT head coach Rick Stockstill said. "It was a great win, and I'm happy that we won. We didn't play at times as well as we would have liked to have played, so we have to get better.

"To our fans, a lot of people showed up, and that was good to see. ... Hopefully they'll continue to do that the rest of the season."

Middle Tennessee was close to losing control in the first half but called upon its all-conference safety, Reed Blankenship, to make a few big plays.

On TSU's first drive of the night, the Tigers marched all the way inside the 10 before Blankenship, a Preseason All-Conference USA selection, started his incredible first half with an interception, his first of the season.

Then, after a Blue Raider punt, TSU again marched down the field and scored the game's first touchdown, but on the PAT, Blankenship broke through the line to stuff the kick.

He was far from done.

The Tigers punted twice more before finding their groove again in the second quarter, using 12 plays to get to the MT 12 and threatening to widen their 6-3 lead. On third down, though, a pass into the end zone was picked by Blankenship, his second of the night and eighth of his career.

The junior ended the first half with a team-high six tackles, finishing the game with nine to go with two INTs and the blocked PAT.

"I saw a formation and kind of knew what they were going to throw," Blankenship said. "That's just all about preparation."

As Blankenship did his best to keep his team in the ballgame, the Blue Raider offense started to find its groove late in the first half.

MT accounted for 173 total yards in the second quarter, including an 80-yard pass from quarterback Asher O'Hara to freshman receiver D.J. England-Chisolm, his first-career TD and only catch of the night, to build a narrow 10-6 halftime lead.

The momentum continued into the second half, as O'Hara caught fire both with his arm and feet. He completed 10-of-12 passes in the second half for 186 yards and added another 67 yards on six carries, leading the Blue Raiders to TDs on five of their six possessions after the half.

O'Hara, making his second career start and first at home for MT, became the first player in program history to throw for 300 yards and rush for 100 in the same game. He finished with 367 yards passing, completing 22-of-30 throws with four TDs and an interception, and added another 103 yards rushing on 11 attempts.

In total, MT racked up 604 total yards on just 58 plays for a 10.4-yard average, its first time going over 600 total yards since Nov. 26, 2016.

Nine Blue Raiders caught at least one pass, and three finished with more than 60 receiving yards.

Jarrin Pierce finished with five catches for 74 yards and a score, while Ty Lee and CJ Windham both had 64 yards and a TD apiece. Chaton Mobley added 104 rushing yards on just nine carries with two TDs, all but 1 yard coming in the fourth quarter.

Defensively, linebacker Khalil Brooks had eight tackles, one for loss, and defensive end Tyshun Render had six tackles, one for loss, and a batted pass.

## BLUE RAIDERS SUCCUMB TO EFFICIENT DUKE

**MURFREESBORO** - An efficient offensive performance from the Duke Blue Devils was too much to overcome for Middle Tennessee.

Duke (2-1) made its first trip to Murfreesboro to take on the Blue Raiders (1-2) in MT's annual Blackout game and left with a 41-18 win.

"[Duke] has a really good football team," Middle Tennessee head coach Rick Stockstill said. "We just couldn't stop them. They scored on every possession except the last two possessions of the game.

"It was just one of those nights where not a whole lot went our way."

Behind quarterback Quentin Harris, the Blue Devils' offense made it tough on Middle Tennessee's defense all night long.

Duke won the total yards battle 463-339 and refused to get off the field, converting 8-of-14 third downs and two fourth downs. The Blue Devils averaged 5.8 yards per first-down play, setting them up with an average distance to go on third down of just 4.6 yards.

Harris finished with 237 yards through the air and four touchdowns and another 107 yards on the ground.

"They're a well-coached team," junior linebacker DQ Thomas said. "[Duke head coach David Cutcliffe] knows what he's doing with that offense.

"We just need to execute better and make plays when they need to be made.

Middle Tennessee's offense looked up to the task on its opening drive, going 51 yards in 13 plays before redshirt junior Crews Holt banged home a 41-yard field goal.

Quarterback Asher O'Hara was the catalyst of the drive, connected on all six of his passes and rushing for 16 yards, including a 20-yard run on third and long to set up the field goal try.

O'Hara, a redshirt sophomore making his second home start for the Blue Raiders, continued his strong start to the season. He completed 19-of-27 passes for 201 yards and two TDs and added a team-high 67 rushing yards on 18 attempts.

Through three games, he's completed 70.7% of his passes (63-89) for 785 yards and eight TDs against just two interceptions. He's also the team leader with 202 rushing yards and another touchdown.

"I missed my job a lot tonight," O'Hara said. "I'm just going to look back on film and learn from it, just like we all are."

The Blue Raiders' early 3-0 lead wouldn't last, as Duke scored 34 straight points, converting its first seven drives into scores.

O'Hara rallied MT to two second-half touchdowns, connecting on two passing scores, both to redshirt junior CJ Windham, his only two catches of the night. It was just too little, too late.

Windham finished with 40 yards receiving, while junior Jimmy Marshall led the way with three catches for 42 yards. Senior Ty Lee had three grabs for 19 yards, tying Kendall Newson's school record with 43 straight games with a catch.

Defensively, junior safety Reed Blankenship had a team-high nine tackles and a forced fumble. Senior Chris Melton finished with four tackles, two going for loss.

Stockstill said his defense will work during the team's bye this week to correct too many missed tackles. The offense will also try to find a way to be more consistent around O'Hara.

"We have to tackle better," Stockstill said. "We have to really study and look on what we're doing with everything offensively, defensively ... and really do a great self-evaluation and critique of where we're at."
