

A late Penn State touchdown with 57 seconds remaining sent the Purdue football team to a 35-31 loss in the 2022 season opener at Ross-Ade Stadium.

The Boilermakers (0-1) held a 31-28 advantage after Chris Jefferson intercepted Penn State (1-0) quarterback Sean Clifford and returned it 72 yards for a touchdown with 8:29 to play. Purdue held Penn State to just seven plays and 14 yards on its next two possessions, taking the ball back on offense with 4:28 on the clock. Penn State's defense forced Purdue to punt with 2:22 remaining.

The Nittany Lions then took eight plays to cover 80 yards in 1:25 with Clifford hitting Keyvone Lee for 10 yards and the gamewinning score.

Purdue quarterback Aidan O'Connell finished the night going 30-59 passing for 365 yards, one touchdown and no interceptions. The sixth-year thrower crossed the 300-yard mark for the ninth time in his career, moving him into sole control of fifth in program history. Running back King Doerue found the end zone twice for his second career multi-score game.

Clifford threw for 282 yards on 20-of-37 passing with four touchdowns and an interception.

Both sides had one giveaway that led to points. Purdue's fumble with 30 seconds remaining in the second saw Penn State score with two seconds left in the first half, while Jefferson's interception return for a touchdown swung the momentum in the fourth.

O'Connell connected with former youth football teammate Charlie Jones in his Purdue debut 12 times. Jones posted a career night receiving with 12 receptions for 153 yards and a touchdown.

Purdue's defense forced a fumble on the opening play of the game to set the tone in a 56-0 rout of Indiana State on Saturday at Ross-Ade Stadium. The 56-point margin of victory was the largest for Purdue since a 59-point shutout win over Southeast Missouri in 2011.

The Boilermakers (1-1) tallied 521 yards of total offense with a balanced 232 on the ground and 289 through the air. Purdue's defense held the Sycamores (1-1) to 145 yards of total offense.

The defense posted its second shutout of the Jeff Brohm era. Purdue racked up seven tackles-for-loss, three sacks, two interceptions and a fumble recovery. Sanoussi Kane delivered a punishing hit to Indiana State Tee Hodge on the opening play of the game to pop the ball up in the air into safety Cam Allen's arms.

In the third quarter, Allen picked off an Indiana State pass and took it to pay dirt for a 65-yard touchdown. It marked the first time Purdue has interception returns for a touchdown in backto-back weeks since Ricardo Allen achieved the feat in 2010.

Offensively, Purdue scored a touchdown on seven of its first nine drives. The only two drives the Boilermakers failed to score on started inside their own two-yard line.

Quarterback Aidan O'Connell was efficient in his one half of action with four touchdowns and 211 yards on 17-of-19 passing. Charlie Jones added to his early haul as a Boilermaker with his second straight 100-yard receiving game. The Deerfield, Ill., native snagged nine passes for 133 yards and three touchdowns.

Redshirt freshman Devin Mockobee led the rushing attack with 78 yards on 13 touches with one score. Dylan Downing added 55 yards from 11 rushes. Purdue topped 200 yards rushing for the first time since Oct. 13, 2018, in a win over Illinois.

A Syracuse touchdown with seven seconds left to play handed Purdue a 32-29 loss in its road opener on Saturday in the JMA Wireless Dome.

The Boilermakers (1-2, 0-1 B10) held a 9-3 lead over the Orange (3-0, 1-0 ACC) at the end of the first half thanks to a Devin Mockobee 15-yard touchdown run and a Mitchell Fineran 41-yard field goal in what looked to be a defensive dogfight. Purdue's defense held quarterback Garrett Shrader and the Syracuse offense to just 134 total yards and a field goal in the first half of play.

The script would flip in the second half however, as both offenses exploded for a combined 49 points, 42 of which came in the fourth quarter. Purdue quarterback Aidan O'Connell posted season highs in completions and yards as he finished 39-of-55 for 424 yards, three touchdowns and one interception.

A back and forth second half saw the lead change hands on five different occasions. The teams traded touchdowns until O'Connell's first career pick-six gave the Orange a 25-15 lead with 8:08 left in the game. The Boilermakers would battle right back, as O'Connell found Charlie Jones for a 55-yard bomb to cut the deficit to three before tight end Payne Durham caught his second touchdown of the day to give Purdue a 29-25 lead with just 51 seconds remaining.

Penalties against Purdue aided Syracuse on their final possession as they took five plays to go fifty yards capped off by Shrader finding wide receiver Oronde Gadsden II for a 25-yard touchdown to win the game for the Orange.

O'Connell's connection with Charlie Jones continues to drive the Boilermaker offense. Jones racked up a career-high 188 yards and added a touchdown to become just the fifth power five player to have 100 yards receiving and a touchdown in his team's first three games. Two 50-plus yard strikes from O'Connell to Jones sparked Purdue's fourth quarter comeback bid that ultimately fell short.

Twice in the fourth guarter, Purdue's defense stepped in front of passes from FAU (2-3) quarterback Nkosi Perry to keep the Boilermakers (2-2) in the lead. Midway through the period, Chris Jefferson intercepted a pass at the Purdue 10-yard line and returned to the FAU 35-yard line. Jefferson's second pick of the season led to a four-yard touchdown catch by TJ Sheffield to extend the lead to 28-20.

Following FAU's touchdown with 5:21 to play that cut the Boilermaker lead to two, Cam Allen dove in front of a doublepass on the Owl's ensuing two-point conversion in the endzone to keep Purdue ahead.

The defense stopped FAU's final drive cold on fourth down with 46 seconds remaining. As Perry reached over a pile on fourthand-one, linebacker Jacob Wahlberg punched the ball free, and Sanoussi Kane pounced on the loose ball to seal the win.

Purdue quarterback Austin Burton, starting in place of the injured Aidan O'Connell, threw for a career-high three touchdowns on 21-for-29 passing and 166 yards. The sixth-year passer worked around an interception in the third quarter to lead Purdue to a scoring drive in each quarter.

The Boilermakers finished with more rushing yards than passing for the first time since 2018 against Eastern Michigan, ending with 188 yards on the ground and 166 through the air. Running back Dylan Downing crossed the century mark for the first time in his career to end the night with 133 yards on 15 carries and a touchdown.

Downing was the first Boilermaker to rush for over 100 yards since Zander Horvath ran for 101 yards against Rutgers in 2020.

Purdue's defense intercepted three passes, while the offense rushed for 160 yards and two scores to pull off a 20-10 win over No. 21 Minnesota on Saturday afternoon at Huntington Bank Stadium. The Boilermakers moved to 3-2 on the year and 1-1 in Big Ten play with their first win in Minneapolis since 2007.

Purdue's defense stymied Minnesota (4-1, 1-1) all afternoon long with a trio of interceptions, seven tackles-for-loss, two sacks and six pass breakups. Safety Cam Allen delivered a pair of momentum swings with an end zone interception in the second quarter, before the game-sealing pick late in the final frame.

Facing an offense that averaged 294.5 yards rushing over its first four games, the Boilermakers were stout defensively, limiting the Golden Gophers to just 47 yards rushing. It was the first time Purdue held a team to 50 or fewer rushing vards since 2017 when Nebraska recorded 40 yards on the ground.

Linebacker Semisi Fakasiieiki led the way defensively with eight stops, including a pair behind the line. Seven different Boilermakers contributed to a tackle-for-loss. Purdue's defense allowed just three points off three giveaways on Saturday.

The Boilermakers jumped out to a 10-0 lead in the first quarter. Running back Dylan Downing pounded his way into the end zone for a two-yard touchdown to start the scoring. Mitchell Fineran later added a season-long 43-yard field goal. The defense meanwhile stood tall on Minnesota's opening four drives, forcing a three-and-out, interception by Jacob Wahlberg,

Purdue's offense found its rhythm in the fourth. Fineran put the Boilermakers back in front with a 25-yard field goal with 4:57 to play. The Boilermakers made it a 10-point gap when redshirt Devin Mockobee found the end zone with 3:13 left on a twoyard rush, following a career-long 68-yard carry.

Back-to-back fourth quarter touchdown drives for Purdue sandwiched in between two straight stops on point after attempts gave Purdue a 31-29 victory over Maryland on Saturday at SECU Stadium.

The defense for Purdue came up big for the second straight week against a potent offense. The Boilermakers produced three sacks to go with six tackles for loss and four break ups.

Head coach Jeff Brohm's squad produced two crucial stops with their backs against the wall. Safety Cam Allen blocked an extra point in the fourth that kept it at a six-point game. Then the Terrapins were turned away by a stout defensive effort on their two-point attempt to tie it up with 0:35 seconds left.

Senior linebacker Jalen Graham returned to the field for his first action since the opener against Penn State and led the team with nine tackles (one for loss). Defensive end Khordae Sydnor had a big day of his own, recording a career high two sacks.

Redshirt senior cornerback Cory Trice nabbed his first interception of the year to give Purdue a pick in five of six games this season. Trice's takeaway led to the first touchdown of the day for the Boilermakers.

Quarterback Aidan O'Connell led the way for the offense, going 30-of-41 for 360 yards and two touchdowns. He found ten different receivers on the day to drive Purdue another crucial conference victory at the midway point of the season.

His primary target on the day was tight end Payne Durham. The big man went for 109 yards on seven catches and a touchdown and his huge fourth quarter helped seal the win for the Boilermakers. An endzone snag with 3:19 left tied the game and then a season-long 56 yard catch and rumble down to the two yard-line led to a Devin Mockobee touchdown that sealed the game.

Quarterback Aidan O'Connell threw for four touchdowns, running back Devin Mockobee rushed for 178 yards and the defense intercepted a pair of passes as Purdue outlasted Nebraska for a 43-37 win. The Boilermakers pulled within one win of bowl eligibility and improved to 5-2 on the year and 3-1 in Big Ten play.

The Boilermakers are now 3-2 in one-possession games this season.

Purdue jumped out to an early 10-0 lead early in the first after a two-yard touchdown toss from quarterback Aidan O'Connell to TJ Sheffield and a 37-yard field goal by Mitchell Fineran. The Cornhuskers (3-4, 2-2) responded with 10 straight points to even the score midway through the second.

O'Connell started a 17-point run before the half by the Boilermakers with a 31-yard pitch-and-catch to Charlie Jones. Fineran nailed another 37-yard kick before running back Mockobee found pay dirt from one yard out.

After Nebraska rolled off 13 unanswered points to cut the gap to four late in the third quarter, Sheffield danced around the Cornhusker defense for a 28-yard touchdown. Fineran, who went 3-for-4 on the night, tacked on a 34-yard kick in the fourth, before Jones added his second touchdown catch from two yards out with 6:55 to play to open a 43-30 lead.

Nebraska trimmed Purdue's lead down to six with 5:55 left, O'Connell and the offense ran the clock with a 12-play, 53-yard drive.

O'Connell notched the fifth four-touchdown game of his career. The sixth-year thrower connected on 35 of his 54 passes for 391 yards. Receivers Jones and Sheffield both snagged a pair of touchdown passes and finished with 132 and 70 yards receiving, respectively.

The Purdue football team saw its four-game winning streak come to an end Saturday with a 35-24 loss at Wisconsin.

Running back Devin Mockobee topped the century mark rushing for the third time this season and the second straight week. The redshirt freshman carried the ball 23 times for 108 yards and one score.

Wide receiver Charlie Jones grabbed 10 passes for 105 yards. It was his fourth 10-catch game of the season, making him the fifth Purdue receiver to have four or more 10-reception games in a season since 2000.

The Boilermakers (5-3, 3-2) outgained Wisconsin (4-4, 2-3) 431-381 and finished with 111 yards on the ground and 320 through the air. Quarterback Aidan O'Connell threw for 320 yards, his 13th career 300-yard game, on 31-of-46 with one touchdown and three interceptions.

Down 25-in the third quarter, the Boilermakers outscored Wisconsin 21-14 in the second half. Purdue's punt team forced a fumble in the third that long snapper Nick Zecchino pounced on to set up an eight-yard touchdown pass from 0'Connell to tight end Payne Durham.

Including Durham's score with 4:12 to play in the third, Purdue found the end zone on three of its final four drives including a pair of one-yard runs by Mockobee and O'Connell.

Wisconsin built a 21-3 lead through the first half, scoring on its first two offensive possessions and returning an interception for a touchdown on Purdue's first drive. Mitchell Fineran gave Purdue its lone points in the opening 30 minutes on a 36-yard field goal late in the second quarter.




